Roger's Blue Noble

- A unique and rare tree, like no other

- More Horizontal branching than Noble Fir
- Thicker needles than Noble Fir

Noble Fir

Nordmann Fir

- Most popular tree in Europe
- Modest fir fragrance
- Short, dark green, glossy, soft needles lay flat on the branches
- Angular, semi-bushy branching
- Resists drying up for 6 - 8 weeks



Fraser Fir

- Traditional and symmetrical
- Fragrant and aromatic
- Soft, one inch dark green needles
- Moderately spaced, semi-sturdy branches for ornament display
- Resists drying for up to 6 - 8 weeks
