

**A GUIDE TO THE SEQUENCE OF VIDEO TUTORIALS REQUIRED FOR DIFFERENT STYLES OF CHAIRS – do not worry if your actual chair is not featured – please choose the nearest style and you will be guided to the relevant tutorials.**

**For all projects start by using the free tutorials to guide you through tools, equipment, materials and stripping off.**

**ALSO LISTED IS A GUIDE TO HOW LONG IT MIGHT TAKE TO REUPHOLSTER A CHAIR**

Please remember that all chairs are different! And everyone works at their own speed.

Materials on chairs that have previously been upholstered using staples will take a lot longer to remove than those where tacks have been used. Therefore it is not possible to include the stripping back process within the timescale.

The time taken to renovate will also depend upon the condition of the original upholstery – whether it's just a repair job to the stuffing's or whether you have to start again from scratch.

The number of hours stated below each style of chair in the following schedule is a rough estimate should the project be stripped right back to the frame and reupholstered again to the top cover finish using some of the original materials within.

A Drop In, or Padded Pin Cushion Seat into a Wooden Frame.



Approx. 4 Hours work.

**BACKS :-** if the outside back is all show wood – you must FIRST tack the outside back fabric to the inside back frame FACING OUT!

If the frame of the outside back has a place for tack holes the fabric can be tacked directly onto the back.

No Webbing Required.

Apply Hessian to Inside Back.

Cover small pad of fibre or wadding with inside back fabric.

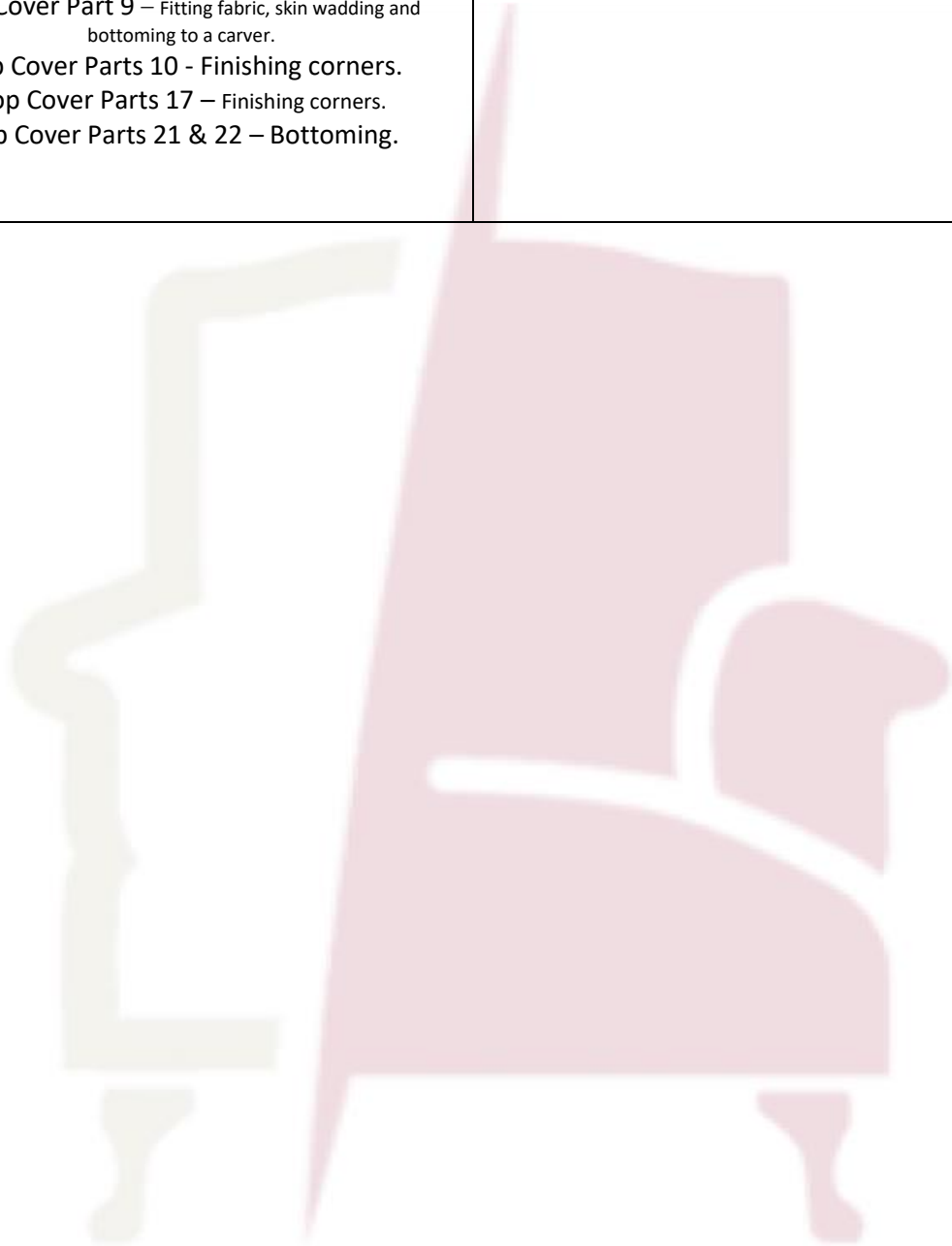

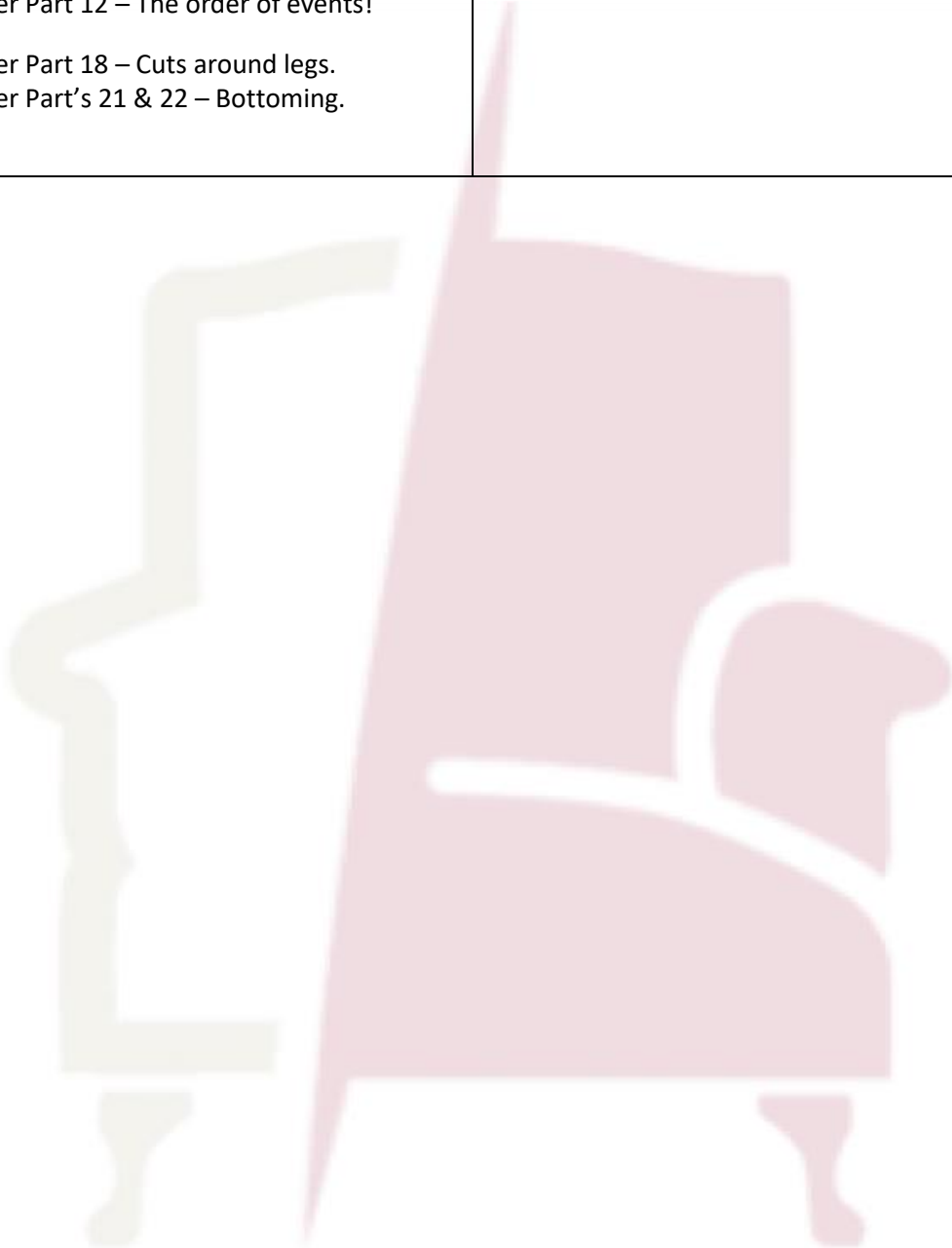

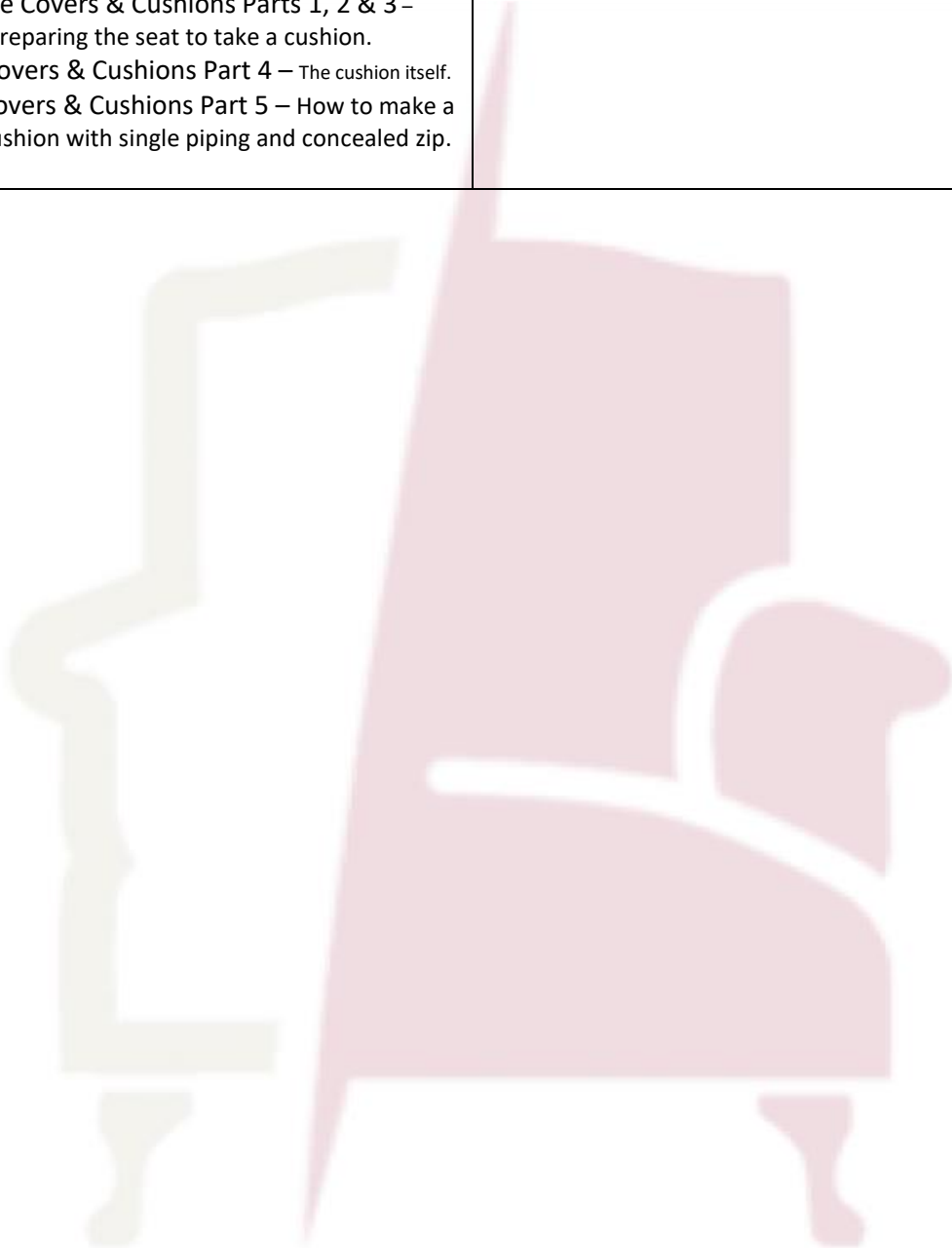
