

## **RECIPE FOR ALISON'S WOOD CLEANER**

To remove old polish, dirt and scratches from polished wood.

Not suitable for bare or varnished wood.

### **Equal Parts:**

*Linseed oil* (Raw is less sticky but Boiled works just as well)

*Vinegar* (not best balsamic! White is “cleaner” to use than malt)

*Methylated Spirit*

*White Spirit*

Use a jam jar not a plastic container and shake well because ingredients separate out.

Use 0000 wire wool dipped into solution and rub gently over frame going with the grain of the wood.

Have an old cloth/duster ready to wipe of the grime-do not leave it sit there while it dries.

NB Flat surfaces are easier to clean than highly carved decorative surfaces so don't “over do” the easy bits in case you can't get rest to match.

Once dry the wood can then take a polish.

Please label your bottle – DO NOT DRINK!
