



RVGCM Guidelines for Crafters

The Jury Committee evaluates all new crafts being sold at Market, through a jury review, to ensure the craft meets the Market product guidelines and criteria. The craft review is based on the following Market standards.

1. Hand-crafted components must dominate any commercial components used and any commercial components must be transformed in a way that makes the work unique.
2. The craft must be handmade, grown, or gathered by the Seller. (Seller is defined as the proprietor of the business or an employee of the business.)
3. The craft must be of high quality and meet basic expectations of product life, function and safety.
4. The craft must be agricultural in nature, defined as being made primarily from natural contents.
5. The craft must be or original, unique work or design.
6. All new applicants, and returning members, must submit NEW crafts to the Jury for review before they are permitted to sell it at Market.
7. New craft vendors with brick and mortar stores will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
8. Upon set up of new crafter's first day at Market, a Committee or Board Member will visit your booth to review your product, booth presentation and answer any questions you may have about the Market.

*All new vendors admitted will be subject to a one season trial period; status will be reviewed after that time.
