# Craft Jet Heat Transfer Paper For Dark Fabric - Blue Line



# Step 1: Prepare your image!

You can print (Inkjet) or draw (crayons, markers) on your heat transfer paper paper. Be sure that the grid side is on the back. Don't reverse/flip/mirror the image. If you want you can cut around your image now.

This paper is NOT compatible with toner/laser printers.



# Step 2: Peel your design.

Peel your design off the backing paper and get ready for pressing!



# Step 6: Press the design.

Press the design onto the garment with your heat press or Iron.



If using an Iron, use the cotton heat setting. Don't use steam.

Using FIRM, STEADY pressure, holding iron with both hands, and applying your body weight, iron on each area of the sheet for 20 seconds.

Lift the iron completely when moving to a new position.

Continue this process until you have ironed the entire sheet. Be sure to cover all corners and edges.

#### **Heat Press:**

-Temp: 375° F

-Time: 25 seconds at medium to high pressure.



# Step 3: Prepare your Surface

Before you place your design on the garment, give the garment a 3 second press with your heat press or iron to smooth out anv wrinkles.



#### Step 7: Peel the parchment or Teflon off!

You can peel the parchment or Teflon off hot or cold. Peal hot for best color retention during washing.



# Step 4: Plan the placement

To avoid designer's remorse, place your new, freshly created design **PRINT SIDE UP** on the garment before pressing. Step back and review the placement. If you like what you see,



#### Step 8: The grand reveal!

Here comes the big reveal! Step back and enjoy! Put it on and be proud of yourself! You did it!



#### Step 5: Parchment Paper or Teflon

Place a piece of parchment paper or a Teflon sheet between the heat press and your design. Don't use wax paper as that will melt and ruin your design and garment.

#### Washing Instructions

- 1. Turn garment inside out
- 2. Wash in cold water
- 3. Do not use bleach or bleach alternative detergents
- 4. Remove garment promptly from the washer (the colour may bleed if left in the washer)
- 5. Dry on LOW temperature

# Step 1: Prepare your image!

Print your image (MIRRORED) with Inkjet onto your heat transfer paper paper. Be sure that the lined side is on the back.

#### Remember to MIRROR the image.

Cut around image if desired.

This paper is NOT compatible with toner/laser printers.



# Step 2: Peel your design.

Peel your design off the backing paper and get ready for pressing!



#### Step 3: Prepare your Surface

Before you place your design on the garment, give the garment a 3 second press with your heat press or iron to smooth out any wrinkles.



# Step 4: Plan the placement

To avoid designer's remorse, place your new, freshly created design **PRINT SIDE DOWN** on the garment before pressing. Step back and review the placement. If you like what you see, sweet!



#### Step 6: Press the design.

Press the design onto the garment with your heat press or Iron.

#### Iron:

If using an Iron, use the cotton heat setting. <u>Don't use steam.</u>

Using FIRM, STEADY pressure, holding iron with both hands, and applying your body weight, iron on each area of the sheet for 20 seconds.
Slide the iron when moving to a new position.
Continue this process until you have ironed the entire sheet. Be sure to cover all corners and edges.

#### **Heat Press:**

- --Temp: 380° F
- --Time: 20-25 seconds at medium to high pressure.



#### Step 7: Peel the liner off!

Peel cool (wait 2 minutes) for a gloss finish. Peel hot (wait 5 seconds) for a matte finish.



#### Step 8: The grand reveal!

Here comes the big reveal! Step back and enjoy! Put it on and be proud of yourself! You did it!

#### Washing Instructions

- 1. Turn garment inside out
- 2. Wash in cold water
- 3. Do not use bleach or bleach alternative detergents
- 4. Dry on LOW temperature
- Do not iron directly on the transferred area
