
Abortion became legal in all nine months of pregnancy on January 22, 1973, with the Supreme Court decisions Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton.

Three Secular Reasons Why America Should Be Under God

The USA Today reported that Norma McCorvey was pregnant when she brought the case, but had her child before Roe was decided so she never had an abortion.

Norma said once, while employed at an abortion clinic, while no one else was there: "I went into the procedure room and laid down on the table ... trying to imagine what it would be like having an abortion ... I broke down and cried."

Allan Parker of the Justice Foundation, in the book *Reversing Roe v. Wade*, documented his 22 years representing Norma McCorvey, the "Roe" of *Roe v. Wade*, and Sandra Cano, "Doe" of *Doe v. Bolton*, both of whom spent the last effort of their lives trying to legally reverse their own cases.

The Justice Foundation gathered testimonies of over 5,000 women who were hurt by surgical abortions and abortion pills.

After decades of millions of children killed, citizens tirelessly prayed and actively got involved.

Finally, the Supreme Court overturned *Roe v.*Wade in the landmark 2022 decision of *Dobbs v.*Jackson Women's Health Organization, clarifying that the Constitution of the United States does not confer a right to abort a child.

This returned the regulating of abortion to individual states.

Liberal mega-donors immediately began a state-bystate strategy, complete with misleading media campaigns and paying workers to collect petition signatures, to put abortion on the ballot, even enshrining it into state constitutions.

The fate of the unborn is now in the hands of every local citizen and church member in each state.

Many church members are waking up to the fact that if they remain silent, they are giving tacit approval to the killing of children, becoming an accessory, an accomplice, and may share in God's judgement.

Leviticus 20 states:

"Any Israelite or any foreigner... who sacrifices any of his children to Molek is to be put to death ...

If the members of the community **close their eyes** when that man sacrifices one of his children to Molek ... I myself will set my face against him and his family and will **cut them off."**

Proverbs

6 states: "The Lord hates ... hands that shed innocent blood."

Proverbs 6:16-19 - There are six things the Lord hates, seven that are detestable to him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, a false witness who pours out lies, and a man who stirs up dissension among brothers.

Babies are the epitome of **innocence**.

It will be a rude awakening for those who think they are holier-than-thou by not getting involved when they wake up to find by their silence they are giving their consent to evil, and will be held accountable!

Those who are just waiting for Jesus to come back and rescue them out of this world are also, by their silence, giving tacit approve to killing children.

And who do you think you will meet when you are raptured? Jesus! Do you think He cares about

children?

Do you think He might ask why you did nothing, especially, being in America where the people are in charge and the politicians are the servants.

Proverbs 24:11-12 indicates warns:

"Rescue those who are unjustly sentenced to death; don't stand back and let them die. Don't try to disclaim responsibility by saying you didn't know about it. For God, who knows all

Rescue those being led away to death; hold back those staggering toward slaughter. If you say, "But we knew nothing about this," does not he who weighs the heart perceive it? Does not he who guards your life know it? Will he not repay everyone according to what they have done?

Proverbs 24:11-12

hearts, knows yours, and he knows you knew! And he will reward everyone according to his deeds." (Living Bible Translation).

The Contemporary English Version words it this way:

"Don't fail to rescue those who are doomed to die. Don't say, 'I didn't know it!'God can read your mind. He watches each of us and knows our thoughts. And God will pay us back for what we do."

The ERV translation puts it:

"If you see someone on their way to death or in danger of being killed, you must do something to save them. You cannot say, 'It's none of my business.' The Lord knows everything, and he knows why you do things. He watches you, and he will pay you back for what you do."

The VOICE version puts it this way:

"If you excuse yourself, saying, 'Look, we didn't know anything about this,' doesn't God, who knows what you are really thinking, understand your motives? Isn't your Protector aware of why you aren't protecting the innocent? Will He not repay you in kind?"

2 Kings 21 recorded:

"Manasseh ... sacrificed his own son in the fire ... The Lord said ... 'Manasseh king of Judah has committed these detestable sins ... Therefore ... I am going to bring such disaster'



... Manasseh also shed so much innocent blood that he filled Jerusalem from end to end."

2 Chronicles 33:33 stated:

"Manasseh ... did that which was evil in the sight of the Lord, like unto the abominations of the heathen, whom the Lord had cast out before the children of Israel."

In other words, a just God will judge a nation which allows the unjust killing of the innocent.

If God does not judge, His silence would be giving consent to the sin, and if God gives consent to sin, He is no longer a just God. **He would be denying**

His just nature -- He would be denying Himself. And 2nd Timothy 2:13 states: "God cannot deny Himself."

God will **judge**, but if a nation repents, He may postpone judgement.

God deals with **individuals** and He deals with **nations**.

Individuals are saved by believing that Jesustook the judgement for their sins upon the cross.



But what about nations?

Colonel George Mason, a founding father from Virginia, stated at the Constitutional Convention, August 22, 1787:

"As **nations** cannot be rewarded or punished in the next world, they must be in this. By an inevitable chain of causes and effects, Providence punishes **national sins** by **national calamities."**

He added that national sins: " ... bring the judgment of Heaven on a country."

When Cain killed Abel, the Lord asked him: "What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from


the ground."

"No woman shall have the legal right to bear a child ... without a permit."


Sanger stated in Woman and the New

Race, chapter 5, "The Wickedness of Creating Large Families," 1920:

"The most merciful thing that a large family does to one of its **infant** members is to **kill it**"

Zell Miller, the last pro-life Democrat U.S. Senator, stated in 2007: "Here is the brutal truth that no one dares to mention: We're too few because too many of our babies have been killed. Over 45 millions since Roe v. Wade in 1973 ... It is not a proper fate for a human being made in God's image."






Senator
Miller stated in a video interview on his book A Deficit of Decency, 2005: "Unfortunately, the National Democratic Party ... has been taken over by

She stated:

"Could it be that when we said we would no longer sit on the back of the bus, a place was begin reserved for us down at the abortion clinic?"

Alveda King told CNSNews.com, December 5, 2016:

"Abortion is ... designed for population control ... The numbers are **higher** in the **African American community**, so that's certainly **black genocide**...

We also discovered that **once black people are made aware** of the **genocidal eugenics by abortion** that the community will **speak out."**

The founder of Planned Parenthood, Margaret Sanger stated:



- "The purpose of the American Baby Code shall be to provide for a better distribution of babies ... and to protect society against the propagation and increase of the unfit."
- "Feeble minded persons ... and others found biologically unfit by authorities ... should be sterilized or, in cases of doubt, should be so isolated as to prevent the perpetuation of their afflictions by breeding."
- "Knowledge of birth control is essentially moral. Its general, though prudent, practice must lead to a higher individuality and ultimately to a cleaner race. ("Morality and Birth Control", February-March, 1918, pp. 11,14.)

Sanger was quoted in "Apostle of Birth Control Sees Cause Gaining Here," *The New York Times*, April 8, 1923, p. 12:

"Birth control is ... cultivation of

suppression, elimination and eventual extirpation of defective stocks — those human weeds which threaten the blooming of the finest flowers of American civilization."

In 1926, Margaret **Sanger** spoke to a KKK group, as cited in her *Autobiography*, published in 1938:

"Always to me any aroused group was a good group and therefore I accepted an invitation to talk to the women's branch of the Ku Klux Klan at Silver Lake, New Jersey, one of the weirdest experiences I had in lecturing."

She stated in a radio interview on WFAB Syracuse, February 2, 1924 ("The Meaning of Radio Birth Control," April 1924, p. 111):

"Just think for a moment of the meaning of the word kindergarten — a **garden of children** ... In this matter we should not do less than follow the example of the **professional gardener**.

Every expert gardener knows that the individual plant

must be **properly spaced**, rooted in a rich nourishing soil, and provided with sufficient air and sunlight.

He knows that no plant would have a fair chance of life if it were overcrowded or **choked by weeds** ... If plants, and live stock as well, require space and air, sunlight and love, children need them even more ...

A farmer would rather produce a thousand thoroughbreds than a million **runts**. How are we to **breed a race of human thoroughbreds** unless we follow the same plan? We must make this country into a garden of children **instead of a disorderly back lot** overrun with **human weeds**."

Margaret



Sanger's address to the New History Society, New York City, January 1, 1932, was summarized in "A Plan for Peace," April 1932, pp. 107-108:

"Keep the doors of immigration closed to the entrance of certain aliens whose condition is known to be detrimental to the stamina of the race, such as feebleminded, idiots, morons, insane, syphilitic, epileptic ... and others in this class barred by the immigration laws of 1924 ...

Apply a stern and **rigid policy of sterilization** and **segregation** to that grade of population whose **progeny is tainted**, or whose **inheritance** is such that **objectionable traits** may be transmitted to **offspring** ...

Insure the country against future burdens of maintenance for numerous **offspring** as may be born of **feeble-minded parents**, by pensioning all persons with transmissible disease who voluntarily consent to **sterilization** ...

Give certain **dysgenic groups** in our population their choice of **segregation or sterilization."**

Sanger stated in *Pivot of Civilization*, 1922, chapter 12, "Woman and the Future":

"We are informed that the **psychological examination** of the **drafted men** indicated that nearly half - 47.3 percent. - of the population had the **mentality of twelve-year-old children or less** - in other words that they are **morons** ...

Our 'overhead' expense in **segregating the delinquent**, the **defective** and the dependent, in prisons, asylums and permanent homes, our failure to **segregate morons** who are increasing and multiplying ... demonstrate our foolhardy and extravagant sentimentalism.

No industrial corporation could maintain its existence upon such a foundation.

Yet hardheaded 'captains of industry,' financiers who pride themselves upon their cool-headed and keen-sighted business ability are dropping millions into rosewater philanthropies and charities that are silly at best and vicious at worst."

Supreme Court Justice Clarence Thomaswrote in his concurring opinion of *Box versus Planned Parenthood of Indiana and Kentucky*, May 28, 2019:

"In a report titled 'Birth Control and the Negro,'
Sanger and her coauthors identified blacks as 'the
great problem of the South' — 'the group with "the
greatest economic, health, and social problems"' —
and developed a birth-control program geared
toward this population.

She later emphasized that black ministers should be involved in the program, noting, 'We do not want word to go out that we want to exterminate the Negro population, and the minister is the man who can straighten out that idea if it ever occurs to any of their more rebellious members.'"

A statement printed



in **Sanger's** pamphlet *The Woman Rebel,* 1914: New York, National Archives:

"Birth control appeals to the advanced radical because it is calculated to undermine the authority of the Christian churches. I look forward to seeing humanity free someday of the tyranny of Christianity no less than capitalism."

Justice Thomas continued:


"Some black groups saw 'family planning as a euphemism for race genocide' and believed that 'black people were taking the brunt of the 'planning' under Planned Parenthood's 'ghetto approach' to distributing its services.

'The Pittsburgh branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People,' for example, 'criticized family planners as bent on trying to keep the Negro birth rate as low as possible' ...

These observations echo the views articulated by the eugenicists and by **Sanger** decades earlier: **'Birth Control** of itself ... will **make a better race'** and tend 'toward the **elimination of the unfit.'"**

Historians Will and Ariel Durant, after studying hundreds of civilizations, observed a trend.

They explained in *The Story of Civilization*, Vol. 3-




Caesar and Christ, Simon and Schuster, 1944 (p. 134), that as cultures advanced, women waited longer to have children and had fewer of them, and in less advanced cultures women began having children sooner and had more of them.

This resulted in **less advanced cultures always overrunning more advanced cultures.**

The Durant wrote:

"Family limitation played some part in the history of - the fall of



- Greece and Rome ...

Birth control continued to spread in the upper classes while immigrant stocks from the Germanic North and the Greek or Semitic Eastreplenished and altered the population of Italy...

The ... biological lesson of history is that life must breed ... Nature sees to it that a nation with a low birth rate shall be periodically chastened by some more virile and fertile group."

Margaret Sanger's Birth
Control Review, April 1933,
published an article by Nazi
advisor Ernst Rudin, one of
the "fathers of racial
hygiene,"who wanted
to eliminate inferior
mankind -- "untermensch."



Hippocrates of Kos, circa 460–370 B.C., is referred to as the "Father of Medicine" for starting the

disciplined Hippocratic School of Medicine in the 4th century B.C. Greece.

His attitude, "first, do no harm," was summed up in his work "Of the Epidemics," Book One, circa 400 B.C.:

"Practice two things in your dealings with disease: either help or do not harm the patient."

He is credited with formulating "The Hippocratic Oath," which from ancient times, was taken by all medical practitioners:

"I swear ... I will use those dietary regimens which will benefit my patients according to my greatest ability and judgement, and I will do no harm or injustice to them.

I will not give a lethal drug to anyone if I am asked, nor will I advise such a plan; and similarly I will not give a woman a pessary to cause an abortion. In purity and according to divine law will I carry out my life and my art."

Unfortunately, in recent times, left-wing ideologues have infiltrated the medical profession and endeavored to alter the original Hippocratic Oath.

Being interviewed on his book, *Our Enduring Values-America's Moral Crisis*, **former Democrat**

President Carter stated at the Ritz-Carlton Hotel, Washington, DC, November 3, 2005:

"I've never been convinced, if you let me inject my Christianity into it, that Jesus Christ would approve abortion ... I never have felt that any abortion should be committed -- I think each abortion is the result of a series of errors ...

I have always thought it was **not in the mainstream** of the American public to
be **extremely liberal** on many issues. I think **our party's** leaders ... are **overemphasizing the abortion issue."**

One party leader who may fit the description of "overemphasizing the abortion issue" was Pete Buttigieg, who while campaigning as a **Democrat** candidate for President in 2020, claimed "life begins at breath."

This view departs from Christianity, as Jesus Christ, Himself, was in his mother Mary's womb from the moment of conception.

Jesus, as recorded in the Gospel of Luke, was in Mary's womb from the Annunciation, when the Angel announced to her,

"Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus"

and she responded, "Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word."



The Angel continued:

"The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God."

At that very moment, she conceived.

This is the foundational Christian doctrine called the Incarnation, when "the Word became flesh."

The Gospel of
Luke continued with
another account
confirming that a child in
the womb was alive:

"And behold, your kinswoman **Elizabeth** in her old age has also **conceived** a



son; and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren' ...

When **Elisabeth** heard the salutation of Mary, **the babe leaped in her womb."**

Other Scriptures testify that a baby in the womb is a living person, such as

Genesis 25:21-23




"And Rebekah his wife conceived. And the children struggled together within her; and she said, If it be so, why am I thus?

Psalm 139:13- 15 "You did **form my**




inward parts, you knit me together in my mother's womb ...

because you believe that **every life is sacred**, that every child is **a precious gift from God**.



Right now, in a number of states, the laws allow a baby to be torn from his or her mother's womb in the ninth month. It is wrong; it has to change."






Trump concluded:

That is why we march. That is why we pray. And that is why we declare that America's future will be filled with goodness, peace, joy, dignity, and life for every child of God."





The opposite of Margaret Sanger was **Mother Teresa of Calcutta** stated at the National Prayer
Breakfast in Washington, D.C., February 3, 1994,
with Bill and Hillary Clinton in attendance:

"The greatest destroyer of peace today is abortion, because it is a war against the child, a direct killing of the innocent child, murder by the mother herself,

and if we accept that a mother can kill even her own child, how can we tell other people not to kill one another?"

Exodus 20:13 "Thou shalt not commit murder."



Mother Teresa added:

"Any country that accepts **abortion** is not teaching its people to love, but to **use violence** to get what they want.

That is why the greatest destroyer of love and peace is abortion ...

Many people are also concerned about all the violence in this great country of the United States ...

But often these same people are not concerned with the millions who are being killed by the deliberate decision of their own mothers ...

... Jesus said, 'Anyone who receives a child in my name, receives me' ... By aborting a child, a couple refuses to receive Jesus.

Please don't kill the child ... Give me the child. I am willing ... to give that child to a married couple who will love the child and be loved by the child ...

From our children's home in Calcutta alone, we have saved over 3,000 children from abortion ...

America can become a sign of peace ..."

Mother Teresa concluded:

"From here, a sign of care for the weakest of the weak -- the unborn child -- must go out to the world ... then really you will be true to what the founders of this country stood for."

The greatness of a nation is in how it treats its weakest members: the elderly, the infirm, the handicapped, the underprivileged, the unborn.

Ronald Reagan wrote in his article, "Abortion and the Conscience of the Nation," *The Human Life Review,* 1983:

"Lincoln recognized that we could not survive as a free land when some men could decide that others were not fit to be free and should be slaves ...

Likewise, we cannot survive as a free nation when some men decide that others are not fit to live and should be abandoned to abortion."

Proverbs 13:22 states: "A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children."

America's founders cared about their "children's children," called "posterity."

The Preamble

of the U.S. Constitution, 1787, states:

"We the people of the United States, in order to ... secure the blessings of liberty to

States, in order to form a more perfect Union, establish justice, insure domestic tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general welfare, and secure the blessings of liberty to ourselves and our posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America.

ourselves and **our posterity**, do ordain and establish this Constitution."

If the Constitution is to "secure the blessings of liberty" to "our posterity," then the unborn need to be protected.

Ambassador Alan Keyes stated in a Virginia high school assembly, February 28, 2000:

"How does it secure the blessings of liberty to our posterity, to those generations yet unborn, to kill them, aborting them in the womb?"

Those who fought in the Revolution were willing to sacrifice their prosperity for their posterity, pledging their lives and their fortunes.



Colonel William Prescott who fought at the Battle of Bunker Hill, stated in August of 1774:

"Our forefathers passed the vast Atlantic, spent their blood and treasure, that they might enjoy their liberties, both civil and religious, and **transmit them to their posterity** ...

Now if we should give them up, can **our children** rise up and call us blessed?"

Dr. Joseph Warren, who died in the Battle of Bunker Hill, wrote in the Suffolk Resolves, September of 1774:

"That it is an indispensable duty which we owe to God, our



country, ourselves and **posterity** ... to maintain, defend and preserve those civil and religious rights and liberties, for which many of our fathers fought, bled and died, and to hand them down entire **to future generations."**

Theodore Roosevelt stated March 4, 1905:

"If we fail, the cause of free self-government throughout the world will rock to its foundations, and therefore **our responsibility is heavy**, to ourselves, to the world as it is today, and **to the generations yet unborn."**

George Washington wrote in his Orders, July 2, 1776:

"The fate of unborn millions will now depend, under God, on the courage and conduct of this army ... We have, therefore to resolve to conquer or die."

On February 27, 2019, citizens of Toledo, Ohio, voted to grant "personhood" to Lake Erie:

(UPI) "Voters in Toledo, Ohio, have become the first in the nation to grant a lake the same rights as a human being."




