EMERGING COFFEE REGIONS







HAITI

Previously hindered by trade embargoes, Haiti is emerging as a coffee-growing country. Haitian coffee beans are known for their mild fruit character and pleasing aroma.



PUERTO RICO

Puerto Rico is gaining a reputation for mild, smooth island profile coffee. This region's beans are mellow and light.



GHANA

Ghana is famous for its chocolate but plans to increase its coffee production intensely over the next decade. Coffee from Ghana is known to have a very rich character and high solubility.



UGANDA

Uganda is fighting to become an acclaimed coffee region. The beans from Uganda often have wine-like acidity and a less complex flavor.

KENYA

Kenyan coffee is gaining rapidly in popularity. It is famous for its berry and other fruit flavors paired with an outstandingly reliable cup intensity.





CAMBODIA

Cambodia has been growing coffee since the 1700s but only recently is emerging as a fair trade coffee. It is known for being very rich and very dark due to traditional roasting methods of the region.
