

KOPI LUWAK COFFEE



KOPI

Kopi is the Indonesian word for coffee.



LUWAK

Luwak is the local name for the Asian Palm Civet, a fruit-eating member of the Viverridae family. It is often called a civet cat, but it is not technically a feline.



ROASTING

Roasting happens after the Palm Civet has passed the beans, removing any risk of contamination.



PASSED BEANS

Enzymes in the Palm Civet's digestive system break down coffee proteins and this alters both the roasted coffee's texture and flavor, removing certain compounds that result in coffee bitterness and acidity.



KOPI LUWAK

Kopi Luwak Coffee has a smooth texture and clean flavor that varies depending on the roast of the beans.
