



WINTER SOLSTICE LANTERN

tutorial & pattern

Download this tutorial to your computer and print it off for personal use! You may wish to print both pages- one with the directions and one with the pattern!

After you've created your winter solstice lantern, be sure to send friends and family to @tanglewood_hollow to find more ways to build stronger connections with nature! To make your own:

- Print the pattern page and cut out the pieces. Trace them on black construction paper (or choose another dark color!) It will need to be dark to create a silhouette at night! Cut the shapes out.
- Cut up pieces of white tissue paper into small squares. Using mod podge, apply a thin layer on a jar with flat sides. Apply the white tissue paper over the entire jar and cover it with a thin layer of mod podge. While the mod podge is still wet, stick the sun, moon, and stars to the sides of the jar. Cover with mod podge. Allow to dry.
- After it has dried, you may wish to use wire to create a handle to hold. It is not necessary, however!
