PRE-INSTALLATION

Tools Required















Materials Included

- 9 long screws
- 9 metal washers
- 9 metal caps
- 3 wall brackets
- 10 wood screws


Materials Required

1 2x6 beam cut to size

INSTALLING SUPPORT FOR THE VANITY

Install 2x6 backing material behind the finished wall to properly secure the vanity.

- To properly secure the vanity, the middle of the required 2x6 backing material must be 27-1/2" (70cm) from the finished floor.
- Extend the backing material beyond the width of the vanity to the nearest stud. This will ensure proper support for the vanity.
- Front-notch the studs to ensure the 2x6 backing material is flush against the studs.
- Secure the 2x6 backing material to the studs with framing nails.
- Rough-in the water supply and drain lines into the rough-in plumbing areas of the vanity.



INSTALLATION

Step 1: Mark the location of the wall brackets.

Step 2: The distances of the wall brackets are 19-3/4" (50.1cm) and 20-1/2" (52.1cm).

Verify the markings in step 1 are level.

Drill 5/16" pilot holes, then push the anchors into each pilot hole.

Step 3: Place one wall bracket against the wall and fasten the bolts to each anchor. Place the bolt caps over each bolt.

Repeat the installation for the other wall brackets .




Step 4: Remove the drawer from the vanity. Refer to page 5 to remove and install the drawer.

Slide the vanity over the wall brackets.

Verify the vanity is level.



Step 5: Secure the vanity to the wall bracket using the wood screws provided.

Each bracket requires five wood screws.

INSTALLING THE SINKTOP

Clean the top surface of the vanity Step 1: with a damp cloth.

> Apply a thin bead of silicone where the vanity top will sit on the vanity.

Step 2: Place the vanity top on the vanity.


Verify the top is level with the vanity.

The pressure of the vanity top will cause the silicone to spread. Clean off any excess silicone with a damp cloth immediately.




Attach the drawer to the vanity by following the instructions on page 5.




REMOVE DRAWER






Step 2: Slide and lift up the drawer box.




REINSTALL DRAWER

- Do not allow liquids and moisture to accumulate on the surface of products.

Wood Surfaces
