

Assembly

Place the sleeper frame and mesh basket 'A' onto a flat surface (fig. 1). Hinge both of the legs vertically (fig. 2 - you may need two people here) and insert the middle support frame 'B' pushing it into the square holes until they click into place (fig. 3 & 4). Pull both adjustable legs into the highest position (fig. 5)

Next you need to attach the cross brace 'C' using fixing tool 'L' and 4 x 22mm fixings 'I' (fig. 6).

Attach the 2 curved feet 'D' using 4 x 27mm fixings 'J' and the fixing tool 'L'. (fig. 7)

Then turn the bedside crib onto its feet (fig. 8 & 9)

IMPORTANT WARNING

Fix hook and loop fastener straps securely around middle support frame 'B' at both ends. (fig. 10 & 11)

Now insert the mattress base 'E', then place mattress 'F' on top of mattress base. (fig. 11 & 12)

IMPORTANT—when ever you use the bedside crib in Bedside Crib mode, it must be attached to your/the parents bed

Height adjustment

To increase the height simply place your foot on the curve foot of the bedside crib and pull the bedside crib upwards, each click is a pre-set height (fig. 13). To lower, locate the adjustment buttons on the outside legs of the frame (fig. 14). Using your thumb push inwards and up to allow the bedside crib to lower. Repeat on the other side so that the bedside crib is level.

WARNING

Do not attempt to adjust the height of the bedside crib with your baby inside.

The bedside crib can be inclined to help reflux with one end higher than the other. The maximum difference in height between each end should be no more than 2 adjustments. (fig. 15 & 16)

WARNING

Ensure your baby's head is at the highest end in the bedside crib (fig 15 & 16).

Co-sleeping mode (next to your bed)

Unzip both sides of the bedside crib, exposing the top frame will expose the top frame locking mechanism. (fig. 17, 18)

Using your thumb slide the button inward to unlock and lift upwards. Repeat on the adjacent side. (fig. 19) Allow the unzipped side to fall down in the gap between the bedside crib and your/the parents bed.

WARNING

Never leave your baby unsupervised with the drop side down. The drop side is for use when the bedside crib is attached to your/the parents bed in the Bedside Crib mode only.

IMPORTANT - Connecting the bedside crib to your bed.

The bedside crib when used in the Bedside Crib mode against a bed must have the bed connector straps 'H' fixed securely to your/the parents bed. This will vary depending on your bed type. For the bed side crib to function safely there must be at least a 3.5cm gap between the floor and the underside of the bed, check your/the parents bed is suitable (fig. 20, 21, 22)

WARNING

Only position the bedside crib on the bed side not at the foot of the bed.

Connecting to a framed bed type

Unwrap both bed connector straps 'H' to the full length. Connect the buckles at the very end of the strap to the buckles just below the mesh basket of the bedside crib (fig. 23)

Then secure the straps around the bed frame (fig. 24) by connecting the second set of buckles (fig. 25). This should form 2 loops connecting the bedside crib to the bed frame. (fig. 26)

Now pull on the surplus straps through the buckle to pull the bedside crib close to your/the parent bed. (fig. 26)

Make sure the curved wooden feet 'D' are flat on the floor and are part way under the bed.

IMPORTANT Check the gap between the bedside crib and your/the parents bed mattress is no more than 2cm. (fig. 28)

Any excess strap should be stored in the mesh pocket found on the underside of the bedside crib basket.

Connecting to a Divan bed type

Check your/the parents divan bed dimensions (fig.22 & fig. 22a). Unwrap both bed connector straps 'H' to the full length. Connect the buckles at the very end of the strap to the buckles just below the mesh basket of the bedside crib (fig. 29)

Feed both straps 'H' between the divan bed base and the mattress (fig. 30). The oval metal plate should be on the opposite side of the bed and be vertical (fig. 31) Now pull on the surplus straps through the buckle to pull the bedside crib close to your/the parents bed. (fig. 32)

Make sure the curved wooden feet 'D' are flat on the floor and are part way under the bed.

If the curved feet do not slide under the divan bed base you will need to remove the 4 x semi sphere feet 'K' (fig.32) keep in a safe place away from children.

WARNING: only operate with all semi sphere feet attached or removed. Never mix some feet attached and some not.

IMPORTANT Check the gap between the bedside crib and your/the parent bed mattress is no more than 2cm. (fig. 34)

Any excess strap should be stored in the mesh pocket found on the underside of the bedside crib basket.

Crib Mode

When your baby is left unattended in the bedside crib, ensure the drop side is raised and securely locked into position. Also ensure the 2 drop side zippers are fully closed.
