Fabric:

Background (light yellow) 1 1/2 yards

Red 1

Print 3/8

Orange 1/2

Bright yellow 3/8

Green 1/8

Whatever fabrics you may choose, just make sure that the “background” fabric is a high contrast to the “red” color .

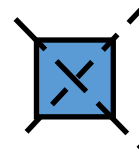
Cut the setting triangles first. Set them aside, being careful to label them so you don't accidentally cut them into smaller pieces!

From background fabric:

Cut 2 squares 18 1/8"



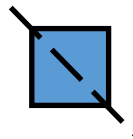
Subcut diagonally, both directions into 8 setting triangles

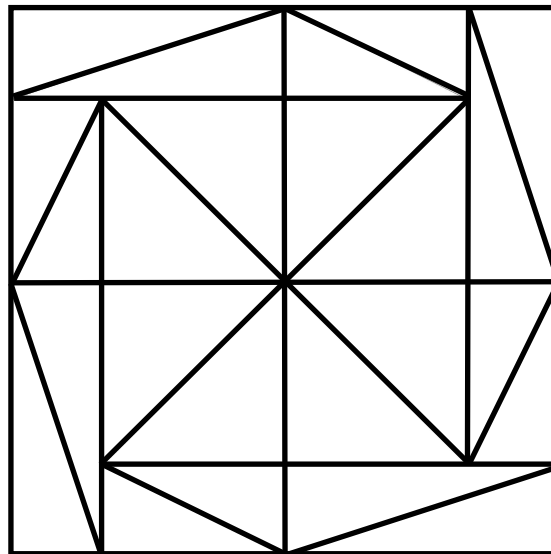


Cut 2 squares 9 3/8"



Subcut diagonally to make corner triangles

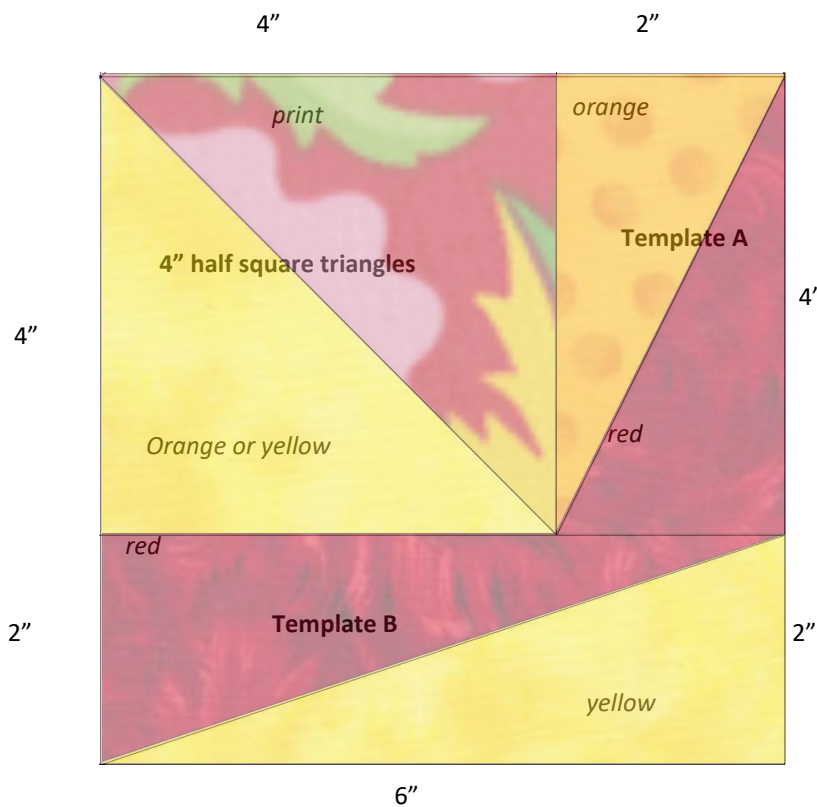




Center Block (make 1)

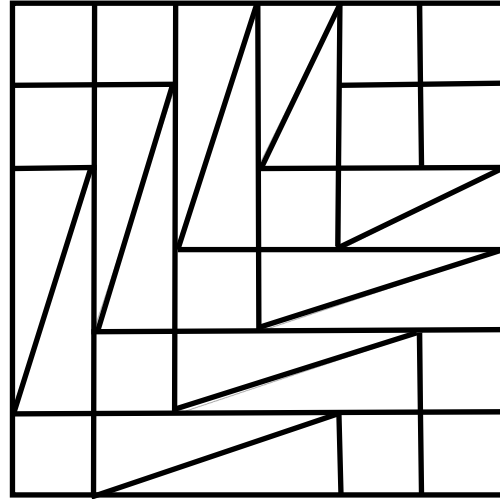
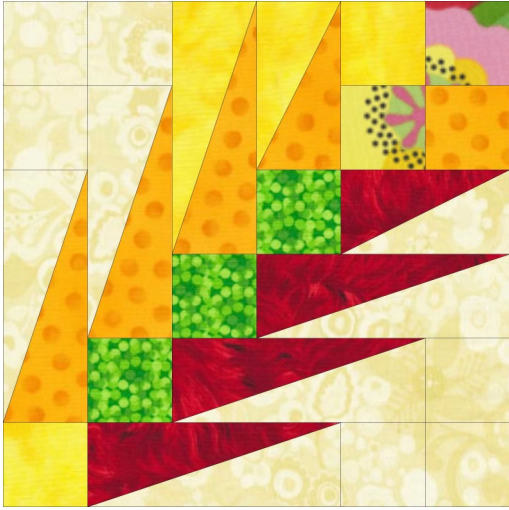
All measurements shown are FINISHED sizes, unless otherwise indicated. Be sure to add your seam allowances!

Block 1



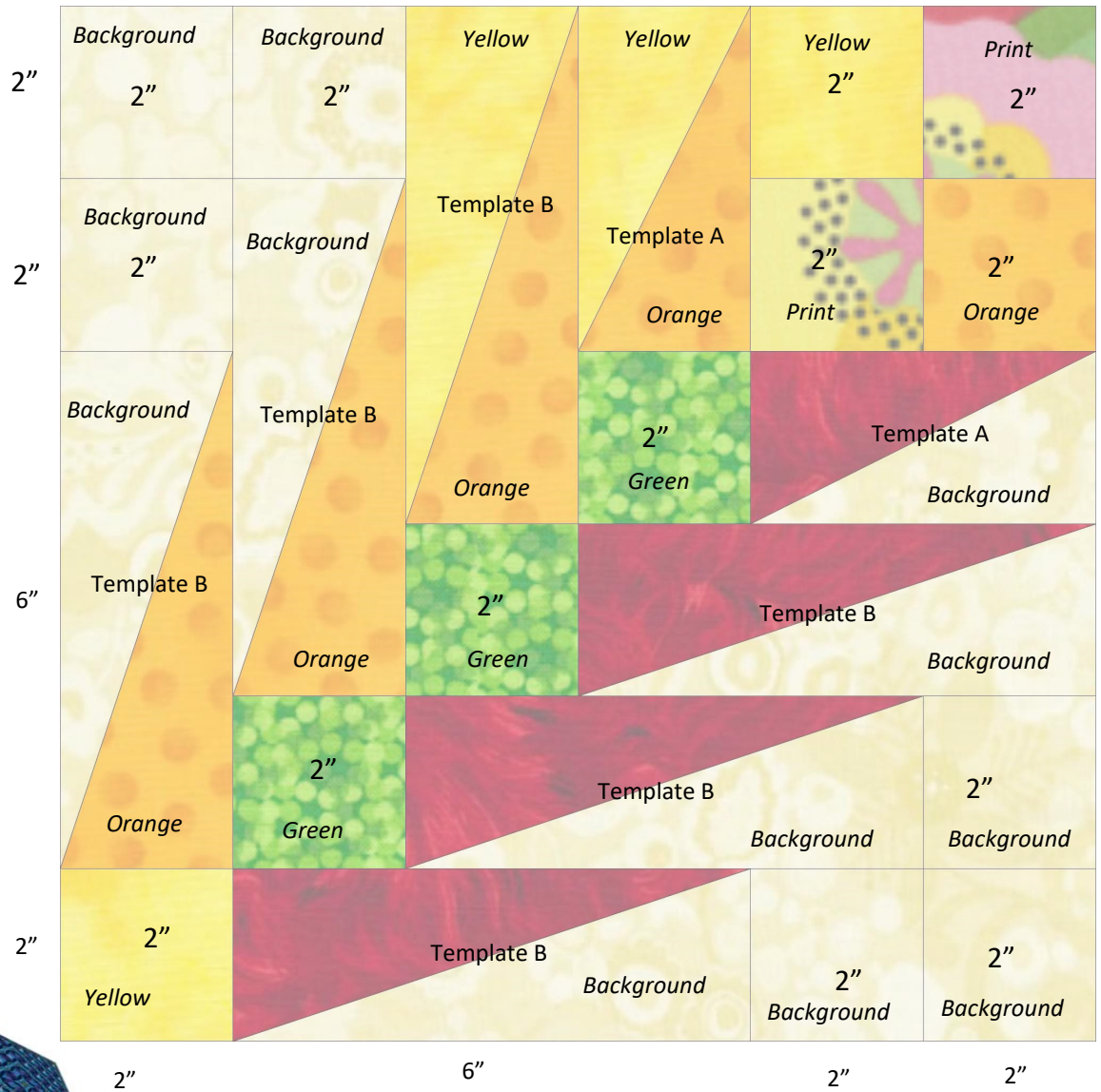
Make 4 (6.5") units as shown below, using medium yellow for 2 HST and orange for the other 2. Assemble units as shown. Should finish at 12.5"

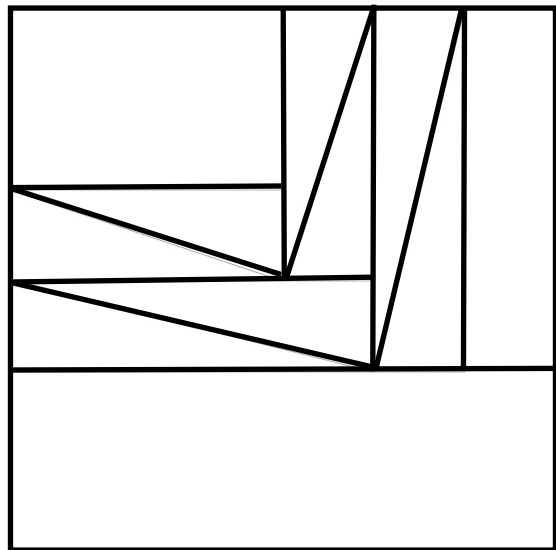




Block 2 "Palm Frond"

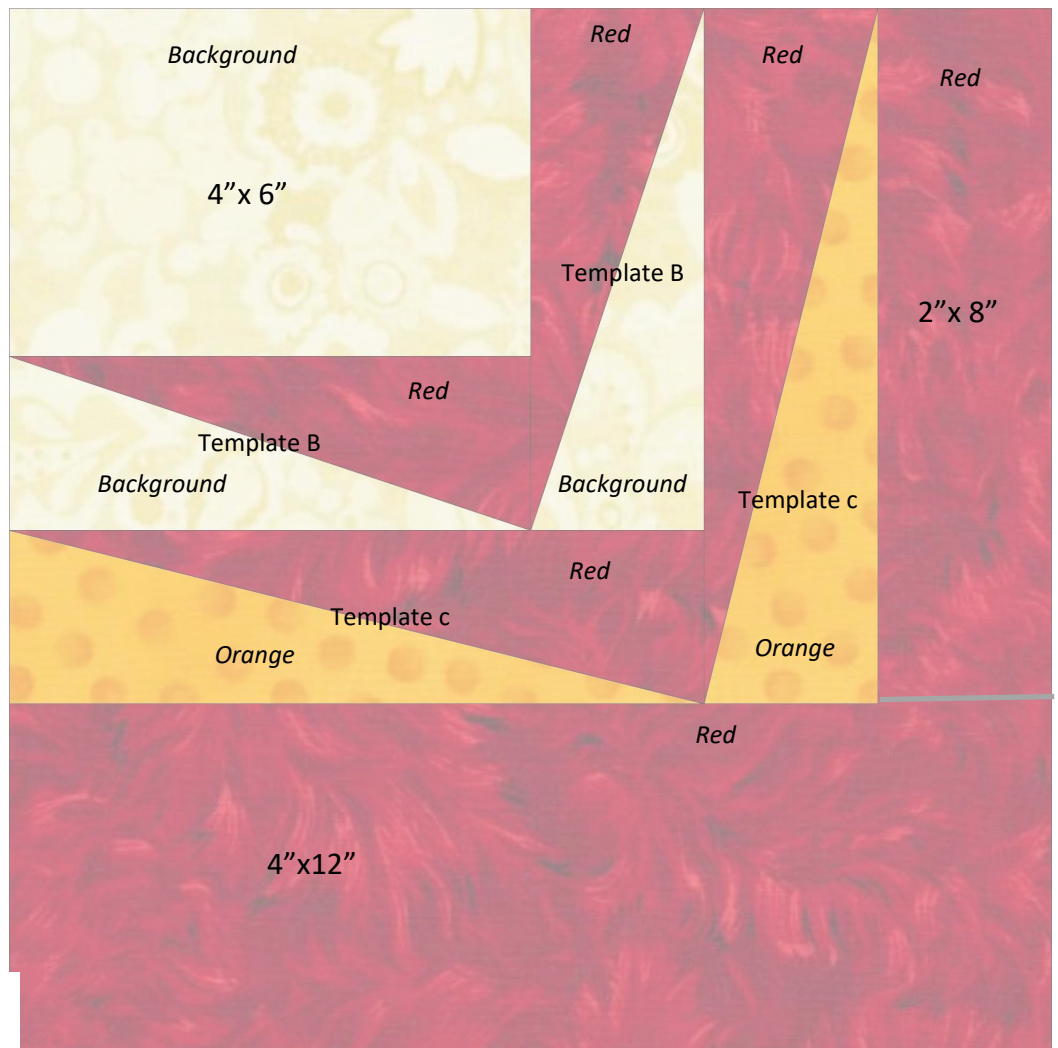


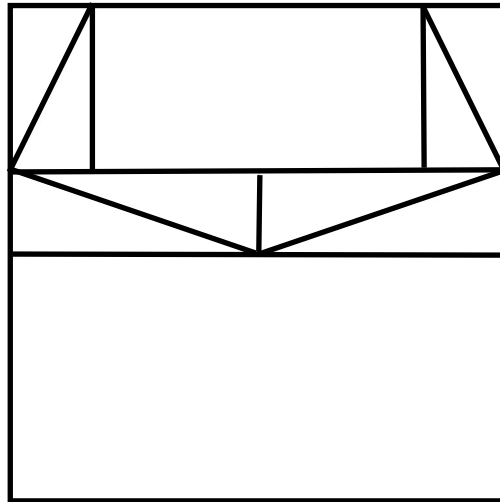

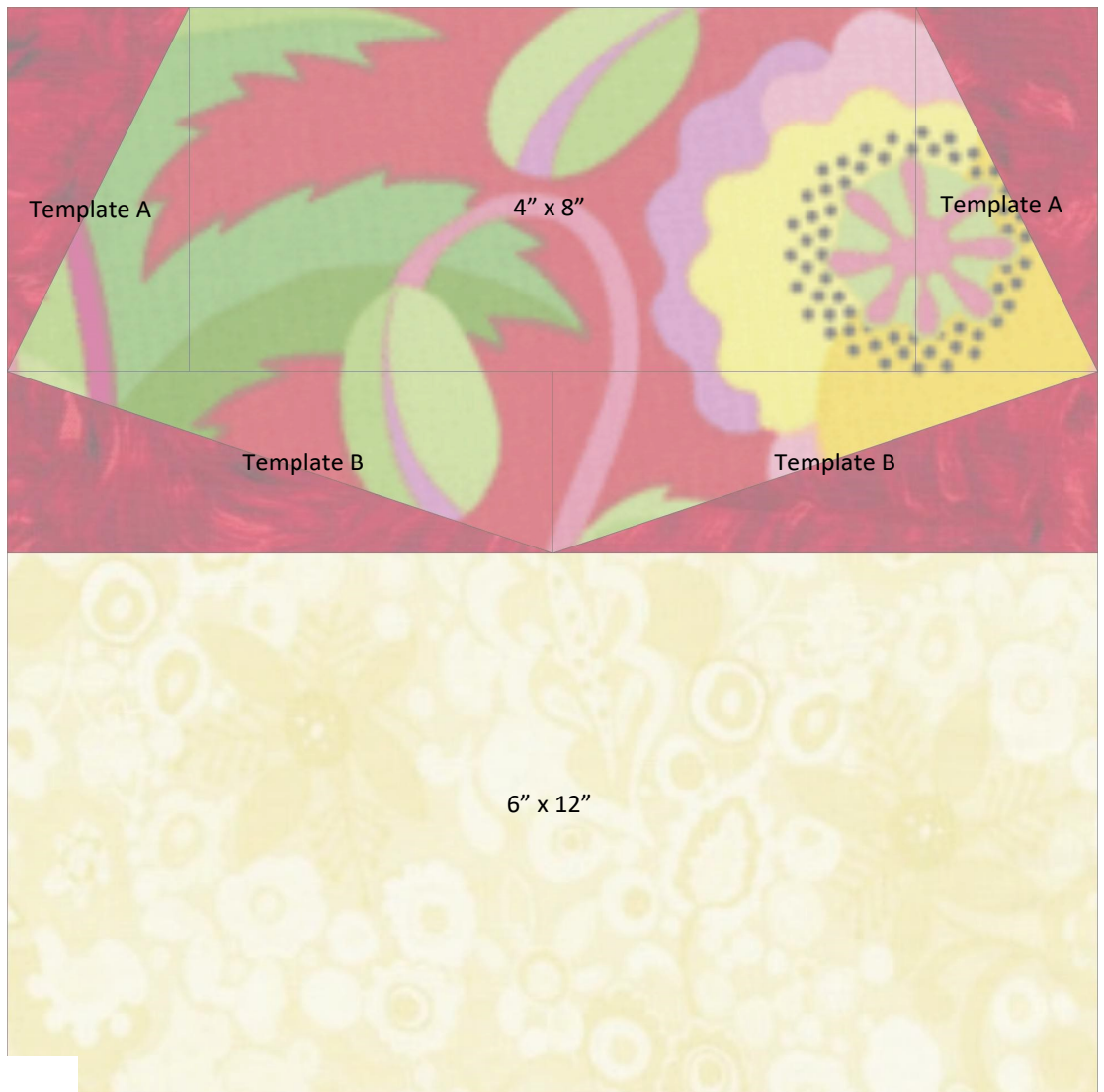
Make 4 of these. Finished size should be 12.5"

Make 4
Block 4



Sew a corner triangle to each of the Block 4 units. Then sew 2 side triangles to 2 of the Block 4 units, as shown.

Assemble remaining 3 rows as shown.

Stitch all rows together.
