

Summer means dragonflies! Their wings shimmer as they dart here and there. This design is all squares and half square triangles. It's a great pattern for scraps, too!

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Fabric:

## Pieceful Dragonfly by Julie Luoma

Yellow $1 / 4$ yard or fat quarter
Green $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ by $18^{\prime \prime}$
Blue 2" x $20^{\prime \prime}$
Brown 2" x 16"

HST = Half Square Triangle

Yellow Fabric:
Cut 1-7" square, cut corner to corner to make 2 HST
Cut 3-3 1/2" squares
Cut 13-2 1/2" squares, cut corner to corner to make 26HST
Cut 6-2" squares
Green Fabric:
Cut 4-2" squares
Cut 4-2 1/2" squares, cut corner to corner to make 13 HST
Blue Fabric:
Cut 8-2 1/2" Squares, cut corner to corner to make 16 HST
Brown Fabric:
Cut 1- Strip 1"x10"
Cut 1—Strip 1"x4"
Cut 1-2" square

Sew yellow HSTs to blue HSTs to make $162^{\prime \prime}$ squares (trim as needed)
Sew yellow HSTs to green HSTs to yellow HSTs to make 82 " squares (trim as needed)
Sew wings as shown (note that they are opposites):


Assemble the head area as follows:
Center the 4" brown strip on a yellow HST, stitch. Press open

Sew another yellow HST to the opposite side of the brown strip. Press open

Trim the block to $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ square


Assemble the section as shown

Assemble the body as follows:
Center the brown strip on one of the large yellow HSTs and stitch
Press open
Sew the other large yellow HST to the opposite side of the brown strip, matching the corners

Press open


Trim the block to $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square


Stitch the 4 sections together
