

#sewpowerfulcards

This note card uses paper and scrap fabric to create an African woman's silhouette with a scrap fabric or paper headdress. What a great way to use up fabric scraps and to custom match a purse! Pattern can be enlarged and used on a purse flap, too!

Supplies

- ✓ Precut cardstock 4x6
- ✓ Cardstock scraps
- ✓ Small, sharp scissors
- ✓ Fabric scraps
- ✓ Heat 'n Bond
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ *African print paper
- ✓ *African print fabric
- ✓ Preprinted message

Instructions

1. Cut out paper silhouette design on right (or save as image and upload to digital cutter) to use as a pattern.
2. Cut dark fabric for face.
3. Cut scrap fabric or African paper for headdress.
4. *Cover one side of note card with African print paper.
5. Lay face fabric on heat n bond. Fuse to back side of silhouette with warm iron. Remove paper backing and place on note card. Fuse to note card with warm iron.
6. Add a greeting and other decorations to the front.
7. Glue pre-printed message (or hand write) on back of note card and sign.
