## Why We Need Your Help

Girls who stay in school all month long are much more likely to pass their 7th grade exam, allowing them to pursue secondary education in Zambia. Failing this test ends all educational opportunities. Imagine girls missing a week of school every month because they don't have the supplies to manage their periods.

It won't take long before the girls are so far behind in their studies that they drop out of school, ending their chance for formal education, better job opportunities and hopes of breaking the cycle of poverty.



Girls in Zambia are waiting for our assistance so they can attend school all month, even on their period. We've helped thousands of students, but there are many more waiting for our help. By 2030 we hope to make our program available to all 3,800 schools in Zambia.








## **How The Funds Will Be Used**

# **How Prizes Will Be Awarded To Individuals**

- 1. The person who raises the most funds will have first choice among the grand prizes.
- 2. The person who ranks second in fund raising will select from the remaining grand prizes.
- 3. Everyone who raises \$500 or more will have one entry ticket for every \$500 raised. Two names will be drawn from the \$500 entries to award the remaining 2 grand prizes by random drawing.
- 4. Everyone who raises \$100 or more, including those who raised \$500 or more but who did not win in the \$500 drawing, will receive one entry ticket for each \$100 raised. The remaining prizes will be awarded by random drawing in descending order of value.
- 5. Everyone who enrolls will receive coupon codes for discounts with select sponsors, regardless of funds raised.

# Rules



- 1. Each prize winner can receive only one prize.
- 2. Groups are not eligible to receive prizes but top producing groups will be recognized.
- 3. \$100 is the minimum amount raised to qualify for the prize drawings.
- 4. All prizes are awarded by drawing a name to match a prize (except for the top two fund raisers). Prizes may not be exchanged or substituted for any another prize.
- 5. Donations may be made online (preferred) or by check mailed to the Yuba City office: Sew Powerful, 229 Clark Ave, Ste O, Yuba City, CA 95991. Unfortunately checks in the mail or any other donations intended for the Sew-A-Thon, not received by September 30th, will not be included in calculating the amount raised for purposes of prize eligibility.
- 6. State and local laws govern prize eligibility. Residents of all US states, except Rhode Island, are eligible to win any of the prizes based on meeting the above qualifications. Due to the complications of laws and regulations outside the US, our international participants are not eligible to win the prizes listed. ## **Participant Recognition**

The top three individual contributors and the top three groups who produce the most purses will be mailed a signed Certificate of Appreciation. They will also receive a mention during the Sew Powerful Live broadcast on October 9th. At the time you report your results, you will be able to indicate whether you are reporting your individual purse counts or reporting for a group.

Sew Powerful is grateful that you, as individual purse makers, and/or as a member of a Sew Powerful Chapter, quilt guild, church group, civic organization, student club, and other group, have elected to support the 2023 Sew-A-Thon fund raiser through purse making. There are many, many schoolgirls in Zambia praying they will receive a Sew Powerful purse with hygiene supplies so they can attend school all month long. Your efforts truly make a difference.





# Communicate With Family & Friends

Sending an individual email, text or social media post is a great way to let your family and friends know about the Sew-A-Thon. Here are some sample messages. Use them as written but a little personalization will bring the Sew Powerful message to life. Remember to replace {#####} in the samples with your Participant Number you received at enrollment.

## **Sample Email**

Hello! This is {name}.

I am involved in a very meaningful project I'm excited to tell you about. For the entire month of September, I will be sewing purses for girls in Zambia as a part of the 2023 Sew Powerful Sew-A-Thon. The purses I make, along with thousands of others, will travel to Zambia where they will be filled with soap, underwear, and reusable feminine hygiene pads for schoolgirls in impoverished communities.

Having access to these pads (a hard-to-get resource in Zambia) allows girls to attend school all month long. This greatly impacts a girl's academic performance, giving her a chance to break the cycle of poverty with a quality education. The pads are sewn by Zambian seamstresses trained and employed by Sew Powerful, providing goodpaying jobs and the dignity of work for these women. This is a life-changing blessing for both the seamstresses and the girls in a country where so many struggle to escape the effects of extreme poverty. You can learn more <a href="here">here</a>.

#### Here is where you come in:




# **Tips From Our Top 2022 Sew-A-Thon Fundraisers**


- Don't be afraid to ask for donations.
   People are truly honored to be part of such a worthwhile cause.
- People will donate because they know and love you. They may not know much about Sew Powerful but if Sew Powerful is important to you, it becomes important to them.
- Be sure to thank supporters who donate on your behalf. You will have a report with the donors' names, amounts, and words of encouragement. It will be easy for you send a note of appreciation. You may want to ask again next year, so please let them know you are grateful for their support now.

# **Tips From Our Top 2022 Sew-A-Thon Fundraisers**

- Send out new email messages and create new social media content once a week. Talk about it in person too. Find new people to ask. After a couple of weeks send a nice reminder to your original list with an update on your purse making progress.
- Write messages/posts with a photo of yourself with one or more of your Sew Powerful purses. These photos were extremely effective in generating donations.
- If you have accounts on multiple social media platforms, post on all of them. You never know who you might miss if you restrict your posts to just one platform.
- Ask people to share your post to expand your reach and to let a wider community learn about our Sew-A-Thon fundraiser.





# 2022 SEW-A-THON RESULTS













#### Q. I don't sew. How can I participate?

A. You are welcome to make note cards, but you should also ask friends and family to make donations. Through your fundraising efforts you will become eligible for the recognitions available based on the financial amount your supporters have contributed to Sew Powerful.

#### Q. I feel awkward about asking friends and family to contribute financially. What should I do?

A. We understand it can be uncomfortable asking friends and family to donate. That's why we've been especially thoughtful in crafting the wording of the suggested message. Typically, friends and family are honored to be asked to contribute to a cause you are so passionate about. Some will give more than others but every gift counts and each is very much appreciated.

#### Q. How will I get the message with the wording asking for support?

A. As soon as you register, you will receive an instruction email for your use only, a second email with the suggested wording and link to make a donation, and a third email that will give you the link to your personalized progress report. Pages 14-15 also have suggested wording for emails and social media posts.

#### Q. Can I post my participation and ask for supporters on social media?

A. Yes, we hope you will! You will also see the example on page 15. We would encourage you to use the suggested message you will receive by return email right after you register. It will be important that your post contain the instructions and link so your social media friends and followers can support you.

And don't hesitate to post updates throughout September and include photos of the purses you make for the Sew-A-Thon fundraiser. Use hashtag: #SPSewAThon2023

#### Q. Should I send group emails or group texts to my prospective supporters?

A. For best results, we suggest that you send a separate message to each of your prospective supporters.

#### Q. Are my supporters making a donation based on the number of purses I make?

A. No. Your supporters are simply recognizing you and supporting a cause you are passionate about. Supporters give what they can; purse makers sew as many purses as they can. Each is contributing to Sew Powerful in their unique way.

#### Q. How will you know how many purses I make?

A. You will report your final results by October 6th. That's why it will be important to keep track of the purses you sew during September. You will find the reporting form <a href="here">here</a>.

#### Q. Should I report the number of purses I send during September or make during September?

A. You should report the number of purses you MAKE. You can send the purses during the month of September or after the Sew-A-Thon is complete. We want to track how many you make.

#### Q. Can I be cutting out purses now to sew in September?

A. Yes you can. We consider this a SEW-A-Thon, emphasis on sewing. You don't have to do it that way, but by having at least some of your purses pre-cut, you are certainly much more likely to sew more in September. We do ask that any purses you have started sewing before September 1, not be counted as part of the Sew-A-Thon, but please do complete them and send them in.

# Q. By looking at my personalized report, I see that I have not raised enough to qualify for prizes. What can I do?

A. Before September 30th, you can personally make a financial contribution to bridge the gap between what your supporters have donated, and the amount needed to qualify for the prize you want to win. Use the Supporter's Donation Form (HERE) and enter your own Participant Number to get started.

# Q. Some of my Sew-A-Thon supporters would prefer to mail a check rather than contribute online. What should they do?

A. We would be happy to accept your supporters' checks. Please have them include 'Sew-A-Thon' and your name on the memo line. Checks should be mailed to arrive by September 30th to: Sew Powerful, 229 Clark Ave, Ste O, Yuba City, CA 95991

#### Q. How do I handle donations of cash or checks made out to me?

A. For a gift of cash or for a check made out to you, simply endorse the check and deposit the check (or cash) into your own personal bank account. THEN go to the Supporters Donation Form <a href="HERE">HERE</a> and enter your own Participant Number to get started. Use your own name and email address as the donor.

In the comments section you can add 'Check (or cash) from [name]'. You will actually be making a donation to Sew Powerful using your own credit card or with PayPal, but you will have the money in the bank from your supporter's donation.



#### Q. Can I sew and contribute as part of a Chapter or team?

A. Prizes will be awarded only to individuals; however group participation will be recognized during our Sew Powerful Live broadcast. Only one member of a group should report the group's total. Individual members of a group can report their individual purse counts and can compete for prizes through fund raising.
