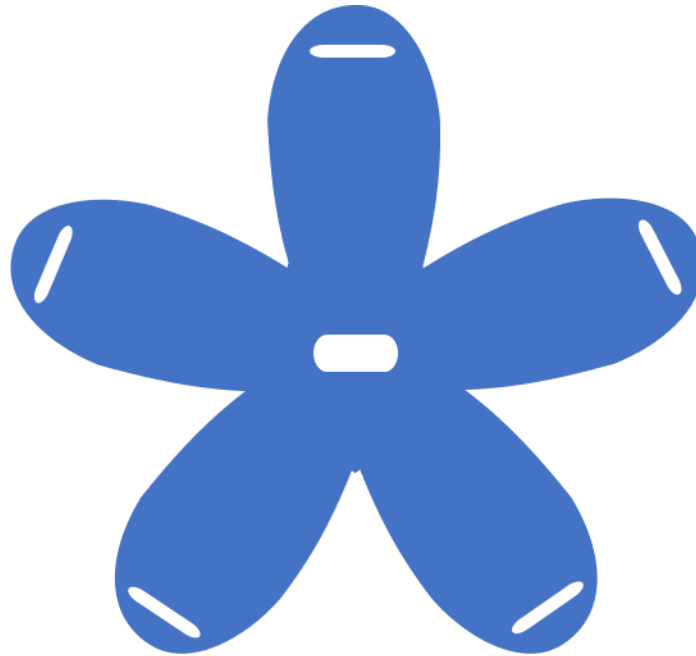


The idea for this week's notecard inspiration is from this tutorial:

My version of it is attached to this post. I used printed cardstock and a 15" strip of 3/8" ribbon. Sewed a button in the center to secure the flower to the card and glued the scripture cutout on the cardstock. I've uploaded this flower template for cutting by hand as well as an SVG file for cutting on your digital cutting machine in the files section. Try it out and post your own in our FB group! PS—you can make one of these out of fabric, too, for a purse flap. Just use Heat n' Bond on the fabric back before cutting!
