

# **Emmett Travel Cot**



**IMPORTANT!** Keep for future reference. Please read instructions carefully before starting assembly.




### **SAFETY INFORMATION** IMPORTANT: BEFORE ASSEMBLING THIS TRAVEL COT, READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS.



- 1. Mattresses are included and are designed specifically for this travel cot.
- 2. Do not use more than one mattress in the travel cot.
- 3. Do not use any mattresses other than the one supplied by the manufacturer.
- 4. Only use accessories recommended by the manufacturer. Never use substitute parts.
- 5. Ensure the top rails and the base are fully locked before use.
- 6. Stop using this travel cot if any parts are broken, torn or missing.
- 7. Failure to follow the warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- 8. Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts or instructions if they are required.
- 9. Keep children away while assembling/disassembling the travel cot.
- 10. Do not leave anything on the travel cot (such as toys) that provide a foothold.
- 11. Do not use the travel cot near naked heat sources, bar heaters, open fires or exposed flames.
- 12. Keep the folding travel cot clear of trailing cables and hanging cords.
- 13. Keep medications and small items that a child could choke on, away from the travel cot.
- 14. Do not use the travel cot if fabric or padding on the side rails or end rails have been bitten through.
- 15. **FALL HAZARD** to prevent falls, **DO NOT** use the travel cot once the infant has reached the manufacturer's maximum weight of 15kgs or a height of 85cm tall.
- 16. The travel cot should be placed on a horizontal floor.
- 17. Never leave your child unattended, for long extended periods of time.
- 18. When a child is able to sit, kneel or pull themselves up.
- 19. Ensure that the cot is fully assembled and all the locking mechanisms are engaged before placing your child in the travel cot.







Place the mattress into the cot and then turn as per diagrams. Find the straps under each mattress corner and pass the straps through the slit at the base of the travel cot.


Once done, connect them to the hook on each foot.



Note: The travel cot is ready to use, but only when the locking mechanisms are engaged. Check carefully that they are fully engaged before using the travel cot.

### **Setting Upper Bassinet Level**





## **CARE MAINTENANCE**

To clean the mattress base and travel cot fabric, wipe it using a mild detergent and water. Never clean with anything abrasive, ammonia based, bleach based or spirit type cleaners.

The travel cot must be dried thoroughly before use or storage.
