

CAMP STONE PACKING LIST

IMPORTANT NOTES - READ CAREFULLY

- 1) The following is a **suggested** packing list for a typical 4 week stay at Camp Stone. If you have any specific questions, please email Lisa Jakobovits, our Office Manager at Camp Stone, and she can help guide you. lisa@campstone.org.
- 2) Laundry is done once a week by our very own Tzevet. **We provide color coded laundry bags for every camper**, and each child's laundry is done individually and discreetly. Therefore, do not send a laundry bag to Camp Stone.
- 3) **Do not send clothing that you care about** to Camp Stone for three reasons: (1) The weather and terrain, while stunning, can be somewhat unforgiving on clothing; (2) Despite the fact that laundry is done individually by camper, items have a way of vanishing from time to time; and (3) When camp is over, we donate all the clothing in the lost & found to those in need in Warren County, Pennsylvania.
- 4) To that end, we strongly recommend **NOT sending new clothing** to camp ©
- 5) Pack only in **duffel bags or suitcases**. No trunks.
- 6) Label everything. First name and last name is perfect.



Clothing

- 8 pairs of regular socks
- 2 pairs of warm socks (wool)
- 15 pairs of underwear
- 12 shirts (e.g. t-shirt, polo)
- 6 pairs of pants/jeans/skirts
- 6 pairs of shorts (knee length only)
- 4 pairs of sweatpants
- 4 sweatshirts
- 4 pairs of pajamas (or extra t-shirts/shorts)
- 1 long bathrobe (for walking to shower house)
- 3 bathing suits (swimming pool & lake activities)

*For lake activities, boys & girls must wear tshirts and knee length shorts

- 1 warm jacket
- 1 raincoat (with hood)

Boys

- 4 pairs of tzizit
- 4 kippot
- Tefillin

Shoes

- 1 pair of rubber rain boots
- 1 or 2 pairs of sneakers for sports
- 1 pair of old sneakers / water shoes (e.g. Keens, Tevas)
- 1 pair of flip flops or shower shoes (e.g. Crocs)

Miscellaneous

- stamped, pre-addressed, envelopes OR postcards
- paper & pens
- 1 pair of glasses

(MANDATORY) - if you wear contacts

1 EXTRA pair of glasses

(MANDATORY) - if you wear glasses

Shabbat Friday Night

Girls

- 3 white shirts
- 3 navy blue skirts/dresses

Boys

- 3 white shirts (button down or polo)
- 3 pairs of navy blue pants

Shabbat Day Boys & Girls

• Appropriate attire for Shabbat

(does not need to be blue/white)
