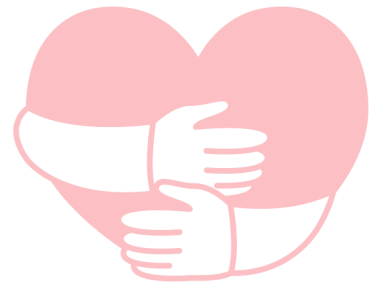


Caring for your adhesive



Store in a cool dry area.

Make sure you clean the spout after every use. (**Do not** use an alcohol wipe!)

If your room has high humidity, store in a glue canister with a silica pack or rice to help cut the humidity.

Keep your glue out of direct sunlight. If your room has lots of windows, do not pop your glue on the windowsill.

Once opened, most glue needs to be replaced between 1-3 months. Every time you use your glue, air gets inside the bottle which starts to neutralize the stabilizers (the ingredients that keep the glue a liquid). The more exposure you glue gets to oxygen while on the bottle, the faster it will start to cure outside of the bottle. Techs that are adamant about amazing retention will change their glue out every month.
