

## Lash Wash

The Sweet P lash wash is a high quality Canadian made product. It's got many organic ingredients and ABSOLUELY NO damaging or toxic ingredients that are found in many other cheaper washes on the market.

## A few things to note about the Sweet P wash:

- -There is a very small amount of tea tree oil in this wash. Tea tree helps ward off any demodex infesations.
- -You will find many natural oils in this wash. They do not affect the adhesive or bond in anyway if you are using an ethyl cyanoacrylate adhesive.

#### Fun fact

Sweet P does discounted rates when your purchase 10 or more washes. They will also allow you to private label the wash with your own label.



-The ph levels of the Sweet P wash are neutral. All lash washes that are used to prep your client's lashes before application should be a neutral ph level. This helps to create an optimal environment of the natural lash for the application process. Should the ph levels need to be adjusted after the fact, see info on Prime, primer.
