3 months

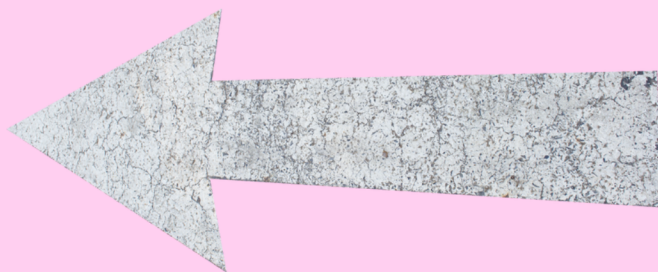
It can take at least 3 months for some techs to feel comfortable with your new skill.

It can take 6 months to 1 year to feel confident in your skill/abilities.

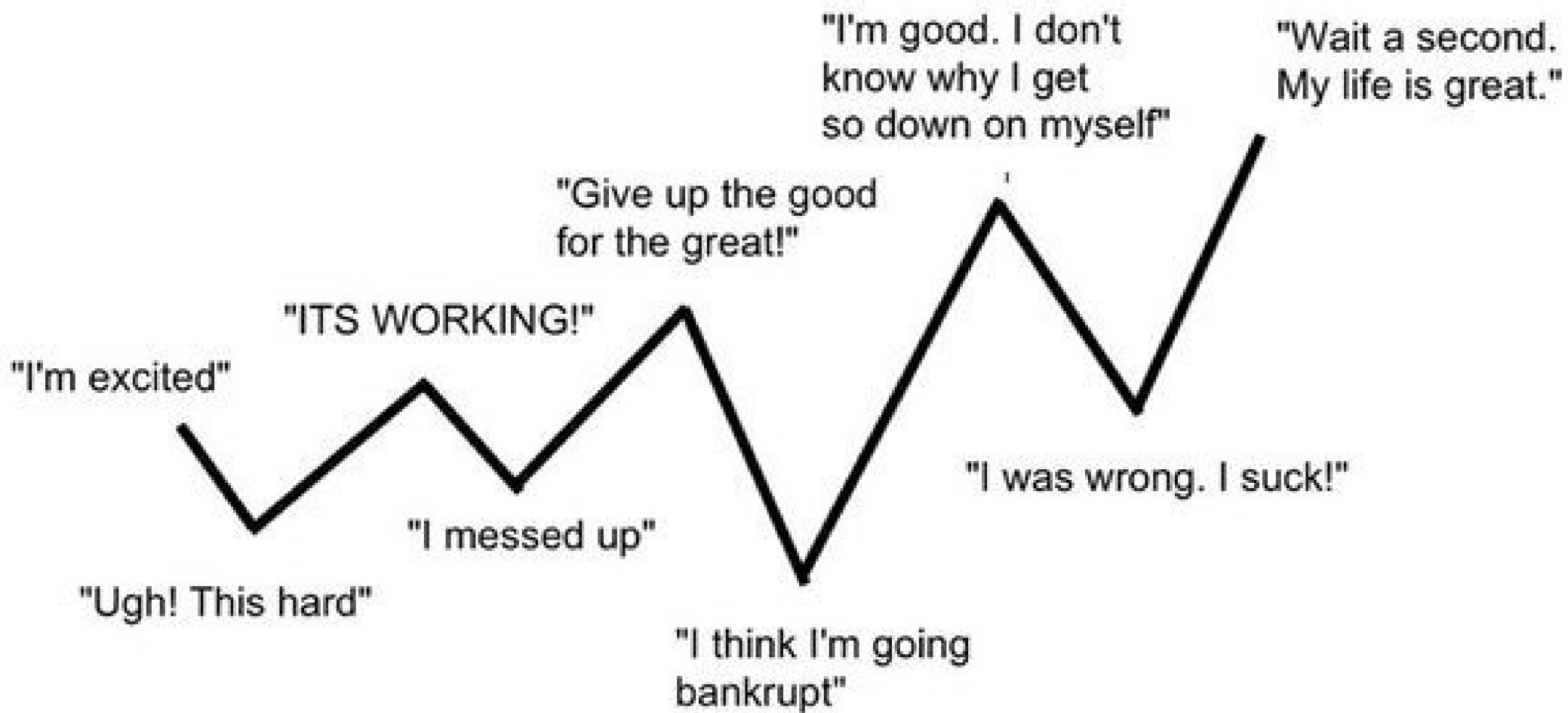
1-2 years
