when asked to give a quote on fills
that are not your work, it's best to
give a range in pricing instead of an
exact price.

Here's how that may sound





"Thank you so much for reaching out (name of potential client)....becuase l'm not able to see what l'd be wokring with, l cannot give you an exact price. What l can say is, it will be somewhere between \$x.00 (l give cost of my 3 week fill) and \$X.00 (cost of a new set)"

You cannot quote a price when you
don't know if it's "just a fill" or a hot
steaming disaster.

If they are adamant about an exact \$, you could also.....
