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**AIRPORTS**: For those traveling by air, we recommend flying into <u>Albuquerque</u> <u>International Airport</u> (ABQ), renting a car upon arrival, and driving an easy one hour to Santa Fe, NM. There is an airport in <u>Santa Fe</u> (very small and charming) but flights are limited and often higher priced. As we are located literally off the map, on the mornings of our events, we will gather at a pre-planned meeting spot (about 45 minutes from Santa Fe), consolidate cars, and caravan to the ranch.

**RENTAL CARS**: <u>Albuquerque rental car center</u> or <u>Santa Fe Rental Cars</u>

**NOTE**: Ridesharing apps such as Uber and Lyft **are NOT** a **viable option** for getting to and from the ranch.

**LODGING:** Medicine Lodge is closest to the village of <u>Pecos, NM</u>. There is camping, lodging, and AirBnBs in and around the Pecos Valley area (<u>Pecos, Glorieta, Eldorado</u>). However, most people choose to stay in Santa Fe which is continually <u>recognized as a top travel destination</u> and offers a wide variety of options for lodging, restaurants, and entertainment for any budget.

*Want to be as close as possible?* Try these inns between Santa Fe and Pecos: <u>Pecos River Cabins</u>, <u>Bobcat Inn</u>,
