FORCE 6 Extrication Leash

Features:

- » 4 feet / 1.22 meters of webbing with a locking carabiner
- » Leash pouch stores excess leash, and mounts to PFD molle or shoulder attachment points
- » Shoulder webbing stabilizer allows webbing to freely slide while keeping leash snug to PFD back
- » This leash will fit all Force 6 PFD models



CARE & MAINTENANCE

- » Inspect leash for damage often.
- » Rinse/wash by hand, and hang dry away from direct sunlight. This will increase the life of the product.
- » Store in a cool dry place away from chemicals.



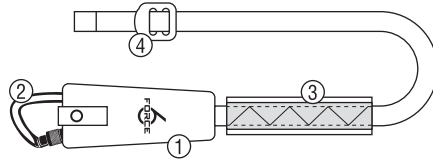

How to use the Extrication Leash

The Extrication Leash is used to attached a carabiner onto the QR (Quick Release) Rescue Belt. This model secures the carabiner pouch firmly with a web/snap and hook & loop, yet it can be easily removed when needed. It can be secured in many locations on the front.



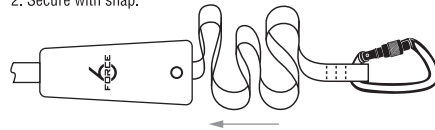
1 - Carabiner Pouch | 2 - Carabiner | 3 - Shoulder Webbing Stabilizer
4 - Triglide Buckle

EXTRICATION LEASH UNIVERSAL

Carabiner Into Pouch

1. Stuff webbing into pouch. DO NOT coil or tangle
2. Secure with snap.



Carabiner Pouch to PFD

Attach directly to loop/Molle. Webbing on back of pouch threads behind webbing on PFD shoulder and snaps onto front of pouch. Many users like the pouch higher on the shoulder.



Attach high on shoulder

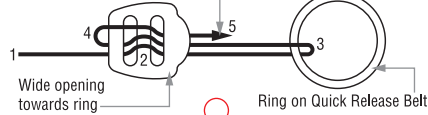


Attach Shoulder webbing stabilizer on back Loop

or attach to molle

TRIGLIDE THREADING

*Thread back through



Wide opening towards ring

Ring on Quick Release Belt
