



## ROSEBUD 2014

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Gabriëlskloof winery is in the Bot River ward, where prevailing southerly winds from the nearby Atlantic Ocean create a mesoclimate perfectly suited to low-yielding vineyards.

Rosebud is an off-dry rosé made with 31% Viognier and 69% Shiraz. On the nose, the prominent rose perfume with hints of strawberries and candyfloss broadens into elegant floral and white stone fruit flavours. A crisp, lively mouthfeel with juicy, sweet-tart berry fruit and a moreish mineral, peppery finish. Delightful now, and delicious up to two years after harvest.
