

ROSEBUD 2010

Gabriëlskloof winery is in the Bot River ward, where prevailing southerly winds from the nearby Atlantic Ocean create a mesoclimate perfectly suited to low-yielding vineyards.

Rosebud is an off-dry rosé made with 59% Viognier and 41% Shiraz. On the nose, the prominent rose perfume broadens into subtle notes of strawberry and caramel, accompanied by a fresh palate-cleansing mouth-feel.
