Extension Activity:

Color the Alphabet



Materials: Color the Alphabet printable, crayons

Purpose: Students will practice letter-sound correspondence with the Color the Alphabet printable.

Procedure:

1. Print Color the Alphabet printable (one copy per student).
2. Say the name of a letter, then say the sound that the letter makes.
3. Say the name of the object that starts with the letter (e.g., “A, ant”).
4. Color the picture. Trace or color the shape of the letter and the word.
5. Keep going until you have colored the alphabet!

Variations:

- Students can complete this activity independently, in partners or small groups, or one-on-one with a helper.
- Laminate the Color the Alphabet printable for repeated use (e.g., in a phonics center).
- Extra practice: encourage students to think of other objects that start with each letter.
- Challenge: encourage students to think of a word that rhymes with each word on the printable.
