Alphabet Adventure Teacher Resources

Extension Activity:





Materials: Color the Alphabet printable, crayons

Purpose: Students will practice letter-sound correspondence with the Color the Alphabet printable.

Procedure:

- 1. Print Color the Alphabet printable (one copy per student).
- 2. Say the name of a letter, then say the sound that the letter makes.
- 3. Say the name of the object that starts with the letter (e.g., "A, ant").
- 4. Color the picture. Trace or color the shape of the letter and the word.
- 5. Keep going until you have colored the alphabet!

Variations:

- Students can complete this activity independently, in partners or small groups, or one-on-one with a helper.
- Laminate the Color the Alphabet printable for repeated use (e.g., in a phonics center).
- Extra practice: encourage students to think of other objects that start with each letter.
- Challenge: encourage students to think of a word that rhymes with each word on the printable.
