# Meg's Sound Hunt Teacher Resources

### **Extension Activity:**

## My Sound Hunt with Meg



Materials: My Sound Hunt with Meg printable, crayons or pencil

**Purpose:** Students will practice letter-sound correspondence and identifying onset sounds with the My Sound Hunt with Meg printable

#### **Procedure:**

- 1. Print My Sound Hunt with Meg printable (one copy per student).
- 2. Say the name of the target letter on page 1, then say the sound that the letter makes.
- 3. Look at the picture. Find objects that begin with the target letter.
- 4. Color or circle each object you find that starts with the target letter.
- 5. Repeat with pages 2 and 3.

### **Variations:**

- Students can complete this activity independently, in partners or small groups, or one-on-one with a helper.
- Laminate the My Sound Hunt with Meg printable for repeated use (e.g., in a phonics center).
- Extra practice: encourage students to think of other objects that start with the target letter.
- Challenge: encourage students to choose
  a new target letter and draw their own
  scene filled with objects that start with that letter.
