Focus Skill: Long /a/
This book features words with long /a/ spelling patterns for decoding practice.

## Decoding Skills:

- Set 1 Skills: Letter-Sound Correspondence, Word Building, CVC Words
- Set 2 Skills: Consonant Blends, Consonant Digraphs, Double Consonants
- CVCe words
- Vowel Teams


## Discussion Questions:

1. On what special day does this story take place? How do you know?

Possible Answers: Kate's birthday / she says "Today is my birthday;" Faith gives her a birthday present
2. How does Kate feel about this day?

Possible Answers: excited, happy
3. What do Kate and Faith do to celebrate?

Possible Answers: eat pancakes, go skating
4. How does Faith show she is a good big sister?
Possible Answers: she makes Kate pancakes; she gives Kate a birthday present; she takes Kate skating; she helps Kate learn to skate


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## Extension Activity:

## Long /a/ Match



Materials: Long /a/ Match printable, pencil, scissors (optional)
Purpose: Students will identify and practice long /a/ spelling patterns with the Long /a/ Match printable.

## Procedure:

1. Print Long /a/ Match printable (one copy per student).
2. Look at the objects pictured on page 1. Say the name of each object.
3. Find the long /a/spelling pattern (at the bottom of the page) that completes the object's name.
4. Write the correct long /a/ spelling pattern to complete the object's name.
5. Keep going until you have all the object names completed.

## Variations:

- Students can complete this activity independently, in partners or small groups, or one-on-one with a helper. Each student should complete their own copy.
- Laminate the Long /a/ Match printable for repeated use (e.g., in a phonics center).
- Extra practice: encourage students to cut the words out (page 3) and match them to the pictures (page 1 or page 2).
- Challenge: encourage students to complete page 4 of the Long /a/ Match printable by writing the full name under each object.
