Application and Directions

Wet hands thoroughly. Apply a small amount onto hands.

Massage into the palm then over front and back of both hands taking care to work well into webs and cuticle area. Ensure both hands are fully treated.

Rinse with clean water and towel dry. Where water is not readily available rub well into hands and dry using a towel or tissue.

Repeat the process on a regular basis.

Health and Safety

for best results...

Clean under your finger nails. Ensure hands are well rinsed. Dry hands thoroughly with paper towel and turn off taps with elbows or paper towel. Dispose of towel in a bin. Use foot operated pedal and not your hand to open bin.

how to dispose...

Dirty, used washing solution should be disposed of via drains that lead only to foul sewers. Do not allow detergent solutions to contaminate surface water drains. In the event that concentrated product should need to be disposed of, run small amounts to foul waste, diluting with plenty of water. For larger quantities, seek advice on disposal from the local authorities. Delphis Eco products are packed in fully recyclable containers. Empty containers should be rinsed thoroughly, the washings being run to foul waste. The containers may then be sent for recycling. Dispose of all waste in a responsible manner. Be aware of the environment.
