

SCHOOL EXCURSIONS at Yallingup Maze

Yallingup Maze provides a variety of outdoor, mind challenging and physical activities. Our activities are appropriate for educational visits, reward days or as a place to go for some outdoor brain teasing fun with your school.

Overview

Our school excursions focus on areas such as teamwork, organisational skills and communication, combining lateral thinking with physical and mental challenges in a fun relaxed environment. Students will apply decision making and problem solving skills, will build trust and learn how to work together as teams using collaboration, strategy, leadership and co-operation.

The Maze Challenge

- Students are split into teams (average size 4 – 6 students per team)
- The challenge is to reach each of the 4 corner towers in numerical order in the fastest time
- All team members need to be present in each tower before moving to next tower
- Teachers are given a recording sheet for times & towers reached successfully
- Teachers are positioned on the bridges in the maze & have access to the students, the central maze tower & the emergency exit

Outcome

Students are given the opportunity to demonstrate flexibility/adaptability, initiative, leadership & ability to communicate. Experiencing first hand that if you work together as a team you collectively achieve a more successful outcome.

Team Puzzles & Games

As part of the experience we offer a range of educational puzzles and games to play. We can tailor the day to suit you and your group making it structured or more relaxed. We work together with the teachers & groups to ensure there is a good mix of games to suit the participants.

- Students can continue to work in teams rotating between individual puzzle challenges, brain teasers & board games.
- Lawn games are offered, including the paving mazes that make a great relay challenge.
- Or if wanting to make it more relaxed, the kids can wonder between the puzzles and games, lawn games and the nature playground.

Outcome

Students need to use judgement, common sense, confidence & problem solving skills.

Duration for Maze Challenge + Team Puzzles & Games – 2 hours minimum recommended.

Water Tag

Water Tag is an organised game using water guns and plastic vests. Players are divided into 2 teams. The aim is to fill up your opponent's vest by blasting them with water. Over time, a small cork rises indicating a score. For most players it's all about getting their opponent wet.

The guns used in water tag are the syringe style guns. Water is sucked up by submersing them & pulling up. Water is discharged by pushing out. These water guns get incredible range. All participants must wear goggles for safety reasons.

Cost is \$5 per child for a session.

Teachers are responsible for the supervision of the kids during play. A change of clothes/ rash vests/ bathers/ towels are recommended. This is a seasonal activity, run over the warmer months.

Catering

Student lunch package \$8 per student.

Cafeteria style 'build your own sandwich' served by our staff, including a piece of fruit and a glass of juice.

Teachers have access to the café menu serving a selection of seasonal meals and freshly brewed coffee.

The grounds of Yallingup Maze offer a well shaded nature playground that is ideal for morning/ afternoon tea or lunch. There is also a large undercover decked area with plenty of seating.

Students are also welcome to bring their own lunch. We provide a water station where students can fill up their water bottles.
