




LIGHT BIBLE VERSE SPINNER


Materials Needed:

- 1 copy of flashlight page and 1 copy of verse circle page per student.
- Scissors
- Paper fastener or brad
- Crayons, Colored Pencils, or Washable Markers if desired.



Directions:


- 1. Cut out both circles, cutting into the flashlight circle along the lines.
- 2. Stack the flashlight circle on top of the yellow circle. Use a paper fastener or brad to attach the flashlight circle to the yellow circle, placing the brad through the dot on the flashlight. Twist the flashlight to play with the spinner.



LIGHT BIBLE VERSE SPINNER

Materials Needed:

- 1 copy of flashlight page and 1 copy of verse circle page per student.
- Scissors
- Paper fastener or brad
- Crayons, Colored Pencils, or Washable Markers if desired.



Directions:

- 1. Cut out both circles, cutting into the flashlight circle along the lines.
- 2. Color the flashlight circle a dark gray or black. Color the flashlight itself as desired.
- 3. Color the images on the bottom circle as desired. Color the background of the bottom circle yellow.
- 4. Stack the flashlight circle on top of the bottom circle, making sure that the images face up on both circles. Use a paper fastener or paper brad to attach the flashlight circle on top of the bottom circle. Place the brad through the dot on the flashlight. Twist the flashlight to play with the spinner.
