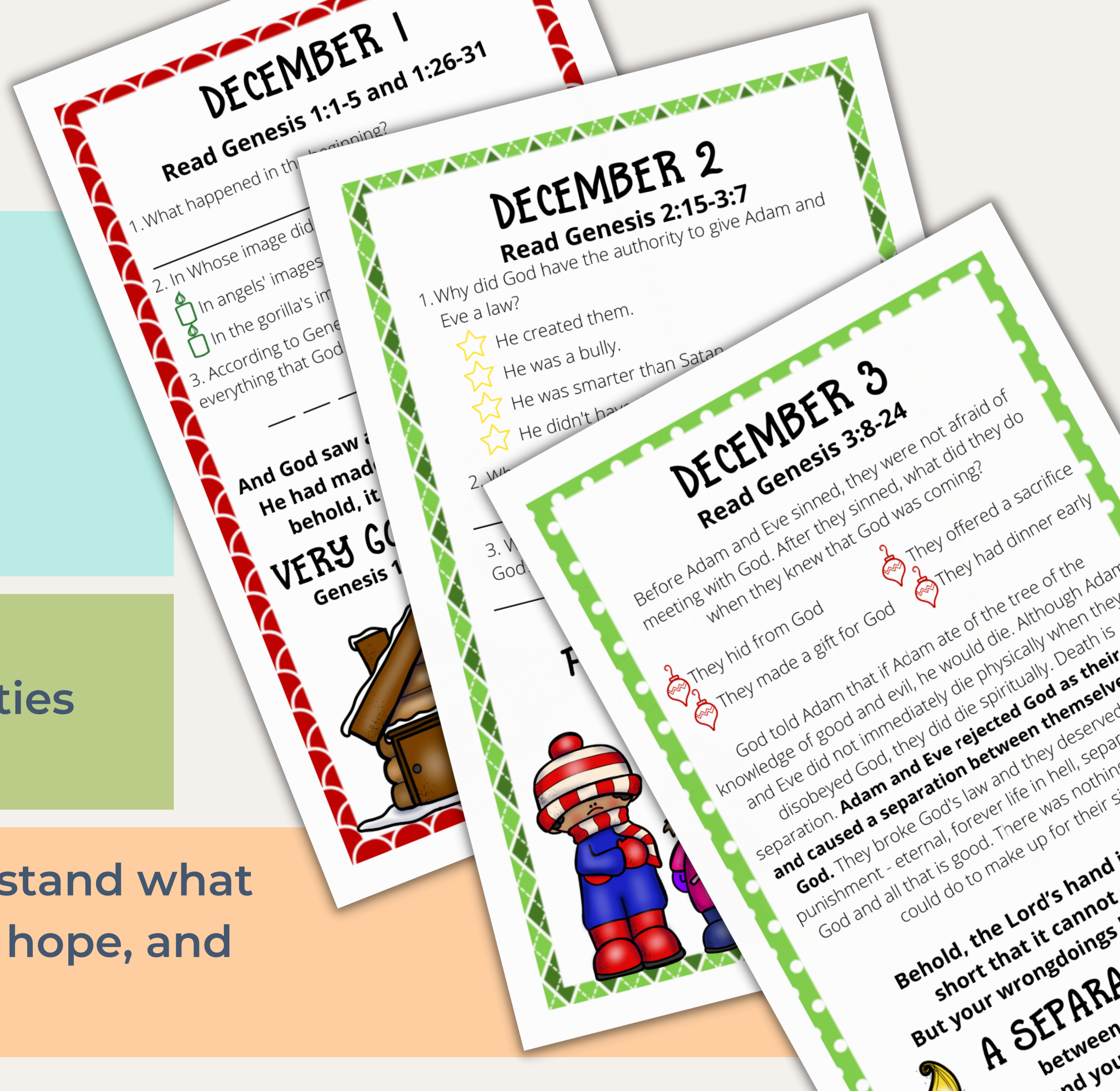

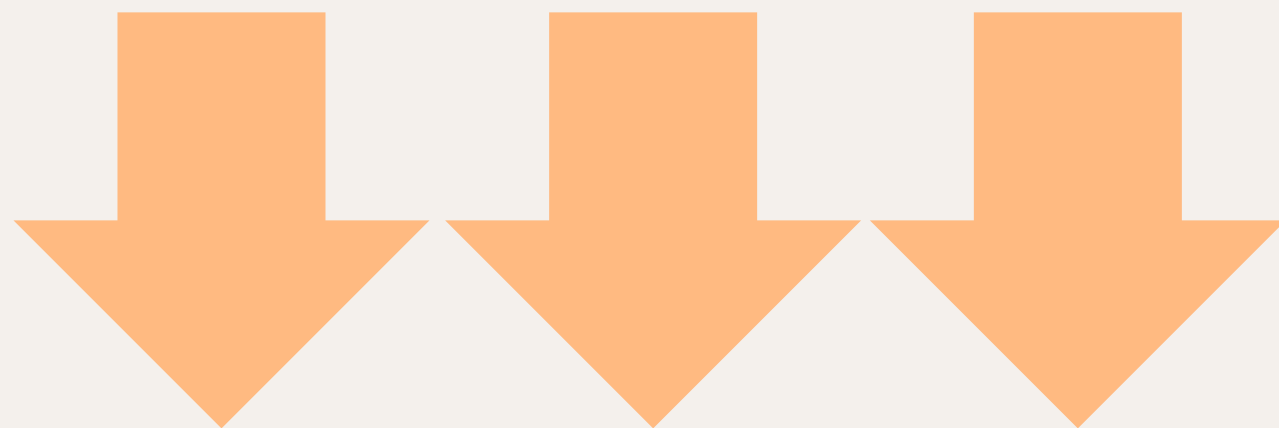

Thank you for purchasing the December Journal Pages!

Before printing, please choose which Bible Version and which color option you prefer.

Open your printer dialogue box and select to **print the pages double sided** and choose **"flip on long edge"** (which is the default setting for most printers).

If your printer does not automatically print double sided, you can print one page, than manually insert the paper so that the printer prints on the reverse side.

After printing the pages double sided, set the first page down on your work surface with the cover facing down. You will see "December 1" facing up at you on the left side of the page. **Stack the pages so that "December 1" is on the bottom, followed by "December 3", "December 5", "December 7", "December 9", "December 11", "December 13", and "December 15".**

When you have the pages stacked correctly, "December 15" and "December 16" will be on the very top of the stack. **Fold the entire stack of pages in half.** The cover should now be facing up at you.

Staple the pages down the spine.

Your Journal is now ready to use!

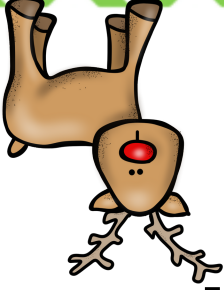

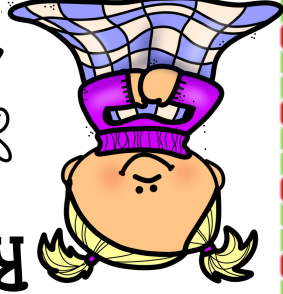
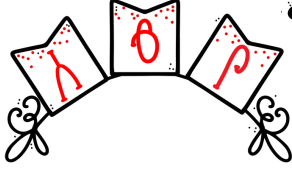
