





Materials Needed:

- Easter Activity Notebook printable pages, one copy per student
 - Scissors
- Pencil
- Crayons/Colored Pencils/Markers
- Stapler

Directions:

- 1.Cut the individual pages out along the dark gray lines. DO NOT cut the front cover page.
- 2. Fold the cover page along the light gray lines, keeping the pictures on the outside of the fold. (See images below.)

- 4. Complete the Bible reading, games, and activities on each page in the notebook.










WHY DO WE CELEBRATE EASTER?

Easter is a special holiday! On Easter, we remember that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came to save us from our sins.

Read Luke 23:33-47
