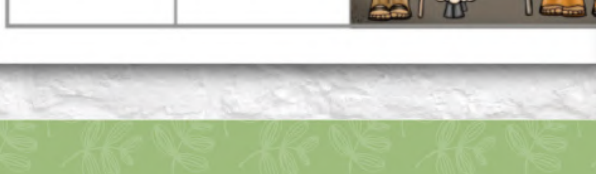
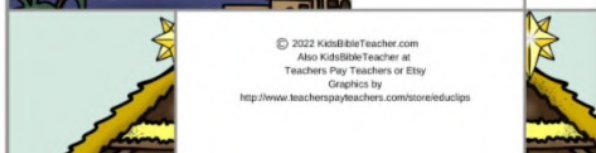
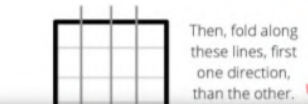
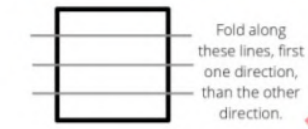
## THE STORY OF JESUS' BIRTH CRAFT

### Materials Needed:

- One copy of this page (or, if you have a classroom, one copy of page 5 per four students).
- One copy of pages 3 and 4, printed on one page double sided, flip on long edge.
- Tape
- Scissors
- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils, if desired

### Directions: (Please see page 2 for picture directions)

- Turn page 3 facing up so that the wisemen and baby Jesus are at top right. Cut the large square out around the outer border. Cut the two rectangles out from the top of page 3.
  - Cut the two rectangles out from the bottom of this page OR from page 5.
  - Fold the square in half. Unfold. Fold again along that same crease in the opposite direction. Unfold. Fold the bottom of the square up so that it touches and is parallel to the middle fold. Fold, unfold, reverse fold, and unfold. Repeat with the top. Turn the square 90 degrees and make these same three folds perpendicular to your original folds. Unfold.
  - Fold the square in half and cut into the center. Unfold and cut out the middle white square along the gray line. Discard inner square.
  - Turn the square over and tape the rectangles (tree, fire, wisemen, and verse) to the square, matching the outer edges. Use the faded images to help you know where and which orientation to put the rectangles.
  - Refold along your original fold lines.
  - Keep the square with the angels / shepherds and manger scenes side up. Fold over so that the bells in the top right corners and the stars in the bottom left corners are touching. Tape the bells to each other and the stars to each other. Flip the rectangle over. Fold the inside up and over so that the holly is touching the holly and the ornament is touching the ornament. Tape the holly to the holly and the ornament to the ornament.
  - Flip the square back over. You should see the angels / shepherd scene. Grasp the top right rectangle from the inside and the bottom left rectangle from the inside and gently pull the scene backward. The manger scene will now pop up. Pull the manger scene back from the inside top right and left bottom. The wise men scene will show up. Gently pull from the inside left bottom and right top and the living room scene will pop up. Continue!
- Tip: If you find that the puzzle is not pulling easily or the images are not lined up correct adjust the images by untaping and retaping as needed.

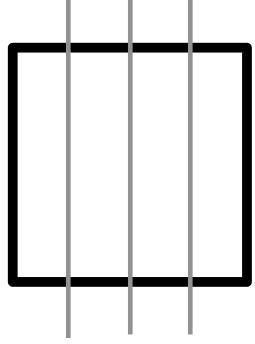
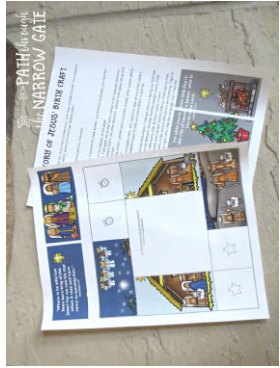

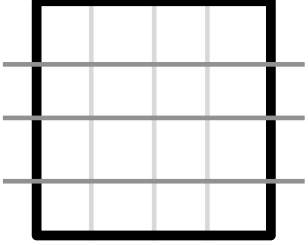

**Tip:** If you find that the puzzle is not pulling easily or the images are not lined up correctly, adjust the images by untaping and retaping as needed.

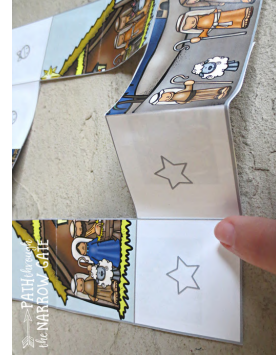
