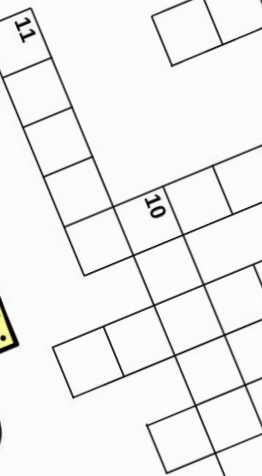

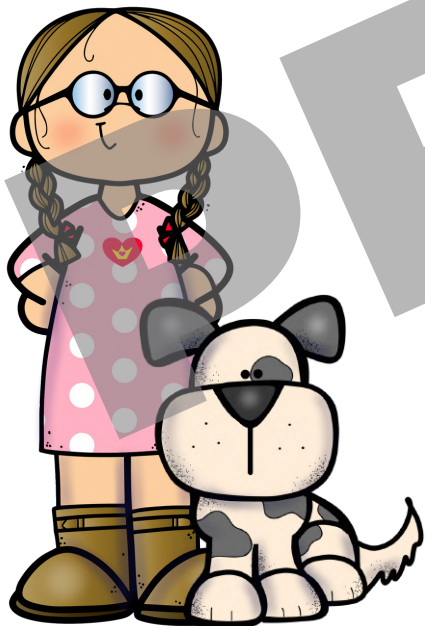

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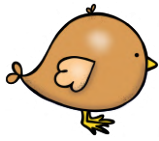

—but the greatest of these is love.

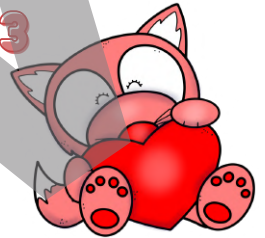

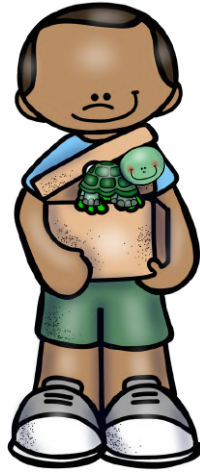

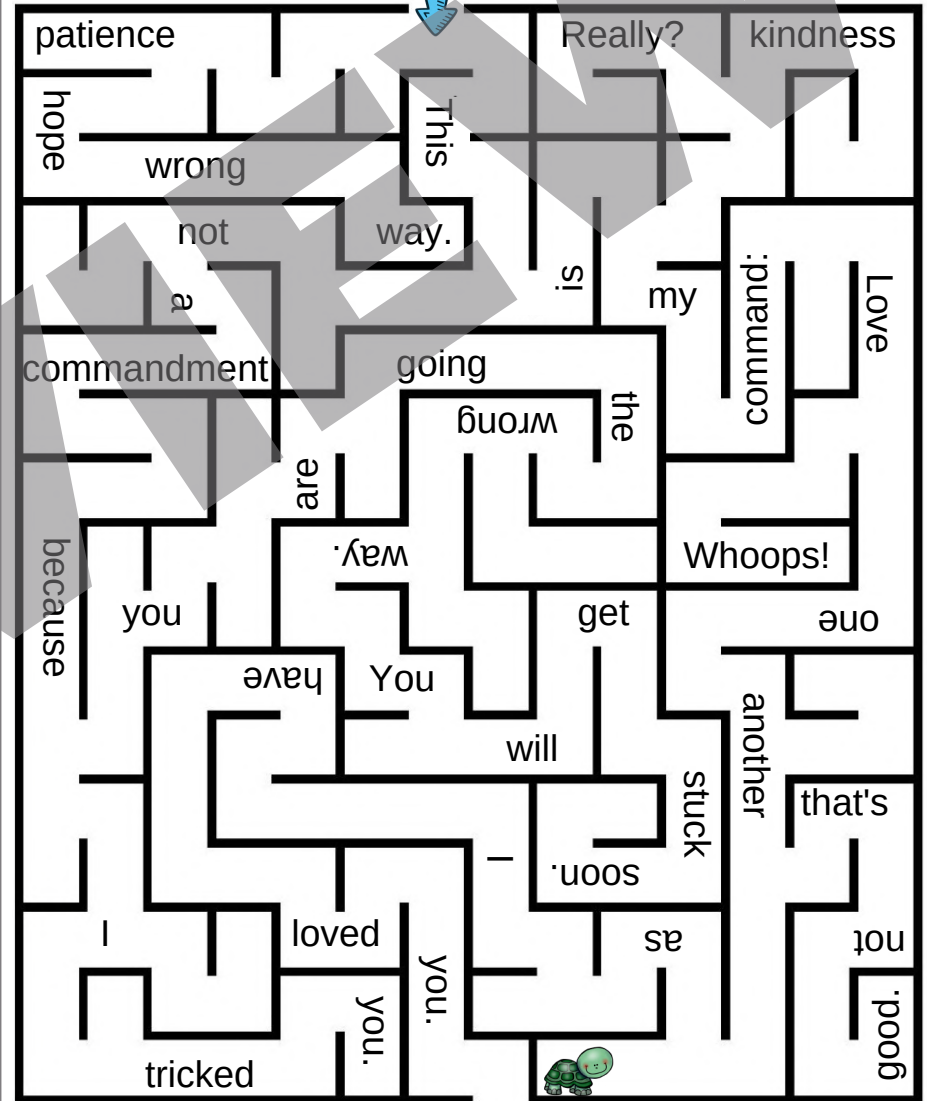
Find the word "loved" in John 3:16 above and draw a heart around it like this:

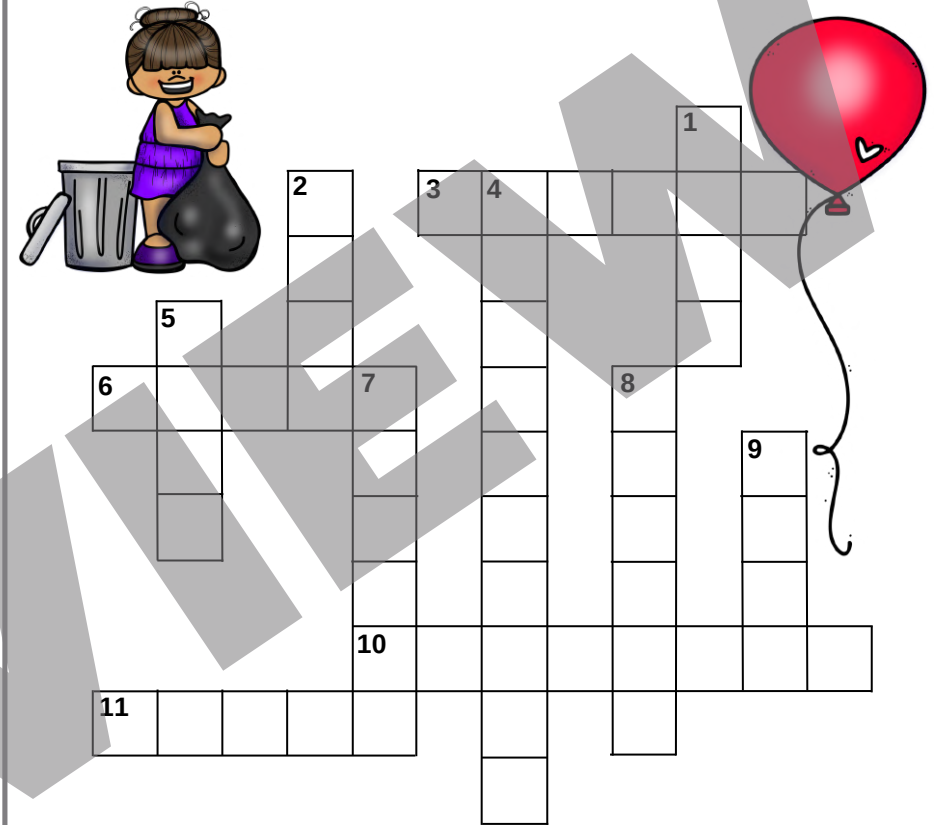
