New Testament Books of the Bible Spinner

Materials Needed:

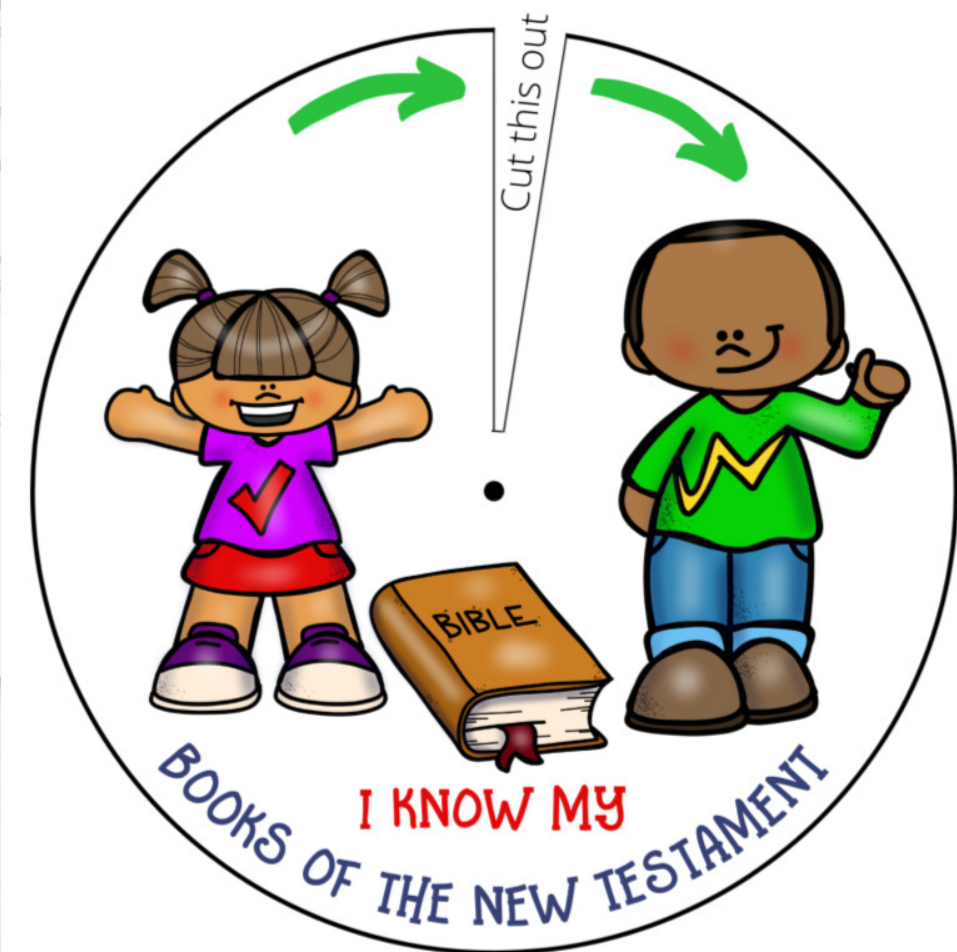
- One copy of each of the two pages below. (You can choose color or black and white outline for your kids to color.)
- Scissors
- One Paper Brad or Round Headed Paper Fastener per child
- Crayons, Washable Markers, or Colored Pencils, if desired

Directions:

- Have your students color the template.
- Locate the template with the two circles.
- Cut into the circle and remove the template.
- Cut the circle with the Bible Book names at all.
- Layer the circle with the children's names on top. Insert the brad or paper fastener through both circles together.
- Twist the circle to reveal the name.

To Play:

- Have kids say the names of the books of the New Testament.
- As they get familiar with the names, have them remember the next name before the previous one.
- Note: It is really helpful to me to start with Matthew through John. Once they know those, continue with the other books.

New Testament Books of the Bible Spinner

Materials Needed:

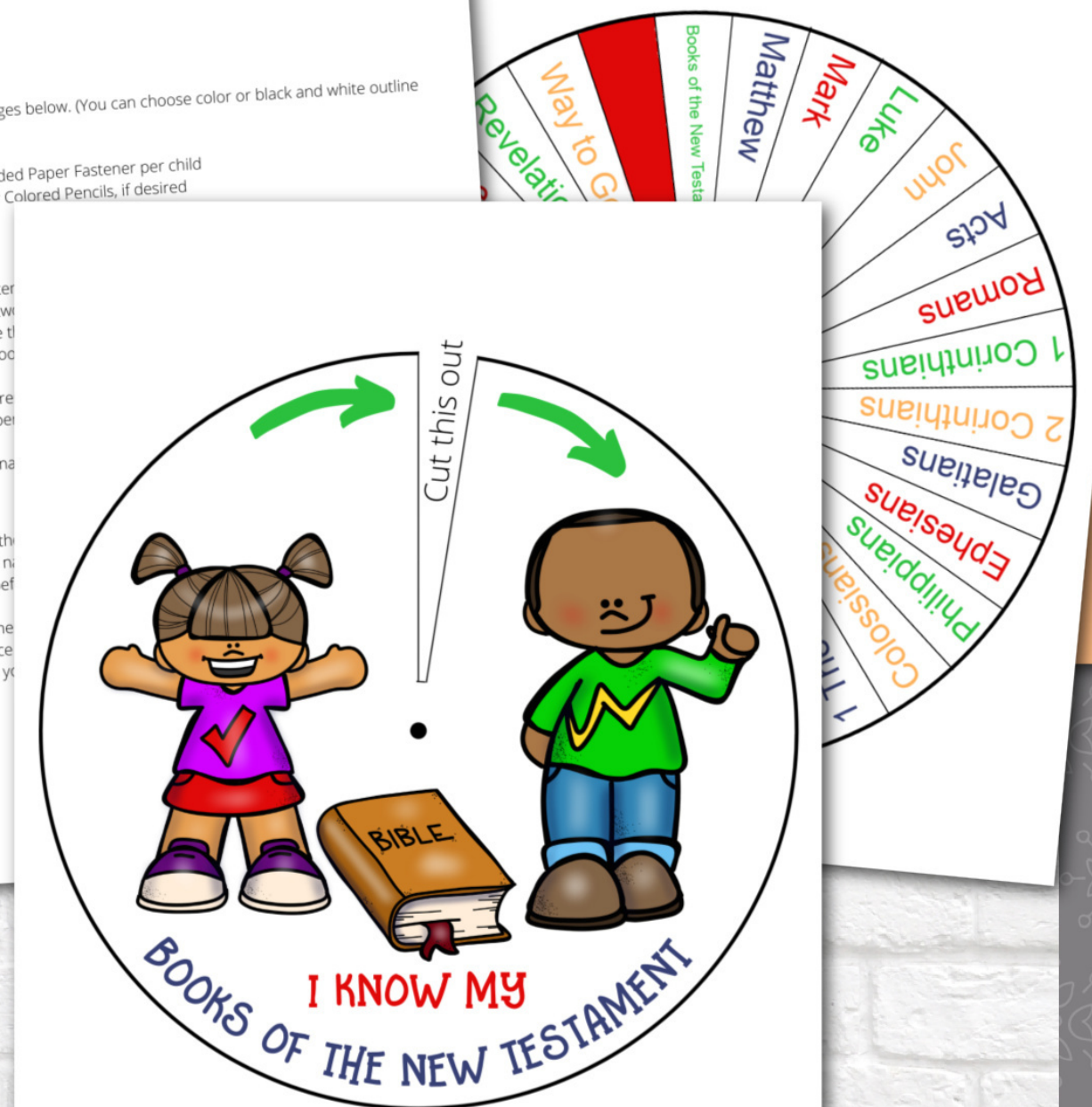
- One copy of each of the two pages below. (You can choose color or black and white outline for your kids to color.)
- Scissors
- One Paper Brad or Round Headed Paper Fastener per child
- Crayons, Washable Markers, or Colored Pencils, if desired

Directions:

- Have your students color the template.
- Locate the template with the two circles and remove the template.
- Cut into the circle and remove the template.
- Cut the circle with the Bible Books circle at all.
- Layer the circle with the children's match. Insert the brad or paper fastener through both circles together.
- Twist the circle to reveal the name.

To Play:

- Have kids say the names of the books of the New Testament.
- As they get familiar with the names, have them remember the next name before the previous one.
- Note: It is really helpful to me to have kids say Matthew through John. Once they get to the end of the New Testament, continue until you reach the end of the New Testament.



New Testament Books of the Bible Spinner

Materials Needed:

- One copy of each of the two pages below. (You can choose color or black and white outline for your kids to color.)
- Scissors
- One Paper Brad or Round Headed Paper Fastener per child
- Crayons, Washable Markers, or Colored Pencils, if desired

Directions:

- Have your students color the templates, if desired.
- Locate the template with the two children on the front. Cut the circle out.
- Cut into the circle and remove the marked "pie piece" along the lines.
- Cut the circle with the Bible Book names out along the outer edge. DO NOT cut into this circle at all.
- Layer the circle with the children over the circle with the Bible Book names so that the edges match. Insert the brad or paper fastener through the black dot on the front page, fastening both circles together.
- Twist the circle to reveal the names of the Books of the New Testament in order.

To Play:

- Have kids say the names of the books of the New Testament, starting with Matthew.
- As they get familiar with the names of the books of the New Testament, see if they can remember the next name before twisting the circle. Then, twist the circle to see if they are right!
- Note: It is really helpful to memorize the books in small sections. You might start with Matthew through John. Once your kids are very familiar with these books, add Acts through 2 Corinthians. Continue until your kids know all the books of the New Testament.
