### DAY 31 Jesus Is Praying for You!

Before Jesus Christ came to earth, people who wanted to be forgiven of their sins and made right with God needed to go to a priest in Israel. They would bring their sacrifices to the priest and confess their sins. The priest would make intercession or "go between" that person and God, asking God to forgive them. But, Jesus Christ changed all of that! He sacrificed His own life on the cross for our sins, and He became our perfect High Priest. Now we can speak directly to God through Jesus.

### Read Hebrews 6:19-20; 7:22-27

What does Jesus Christ do for those who come to God through Him?

What is Jesus Christ doing for those who believe in Him? (vs. 25)

What words describe Jesus Christ, our perfect High Priest? (vs. 26)

### **Read Romans 8:34**

### Jesus Teaches Us How To Pray

### Read Matthew 6:5-13

When we pray, we are talking to God. In these verses, lesus teaches us how to pray. He tells us not to pray like the hypocrites - people who are more worried about what other people think of them than what God thinks of them. 
### DAY 30 Jesus Prays for \_

### DAY 29 What If I Don't Know **How to Pray?**



I hope you have learned a lot about prayer from the Bible in the last month. I am so thankful that we can cry out to God through prayer!

But, **sometimes prayer is hard.** We are children of God and we can cry out to God as our "Abba! Father!" We have hope of a better life in heaven and we are waiting eagerly for a time when God will wipe every tear from our eyes, when we will no longer struggle with sin, and when God will make all things right.

Right now, though, we still live in a sinful world. We continue to struggle with our own sinful hearts. Bad things happen to us. We see bad things happen to the people we love. We get tired, discouraged, and sad. Sometimes, especially when we are going through times of suffering, we don't know how to pray.

The Bible has a **HUGE promise** for us when we are going through these hard times.

### Read Romans 8:14-30


Here are two promises you can take away from these verses:

When you aren't sure how to pray, the Holy Spirit Himself will intercede (go between you and God), praying for you in **exactly the right way.** (Romans 8:26)

The Holy Spirit knows what you need, and **He is working to** make all things work together for good to those who love **God.** He is working in our hearts to make us more and more like Jesus Christ, even through the difficult times. (Romans 8:27-29)

Here's one more promise for you to hold on to during the difficult times:

Read Romans 8:38-39

### **Praying in Jesus' Name**

Paul wrote the letters of Thessalonians to Christians who were suffering greatly because of their faith in Jesus Christ.

### Read 1 Thessalonians 2:14-16

In these letters, Paul told the Thessalonians that he was praying for them. I would expect Paul to ask God to stop the suffering that these Christians were going through. But, Paul doesn't pray for that. While Paul encouraged the people and reminded them that their suffering would end in heaven, if not here on this earth, he doesn't pray for their suffering to end immediately. Paul prayed for the Thessalonians "in Jesus name" - asking God for things that Paul KNEW were according to God's will for the Thessalonians and that Paul KNEW God would give them

### Read 1 Thessalonians 3:11-13; 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12; 3:16

Paul prayed that the Thessalonians would:

- Have **love** for one another
- Have hearts that are blameless and holy before God
- Fulfill every desire for goodness and work of faith
- Be counted worthy of their calling by God.
- Glorify Jesus
- Have **peace** in every circumstance
