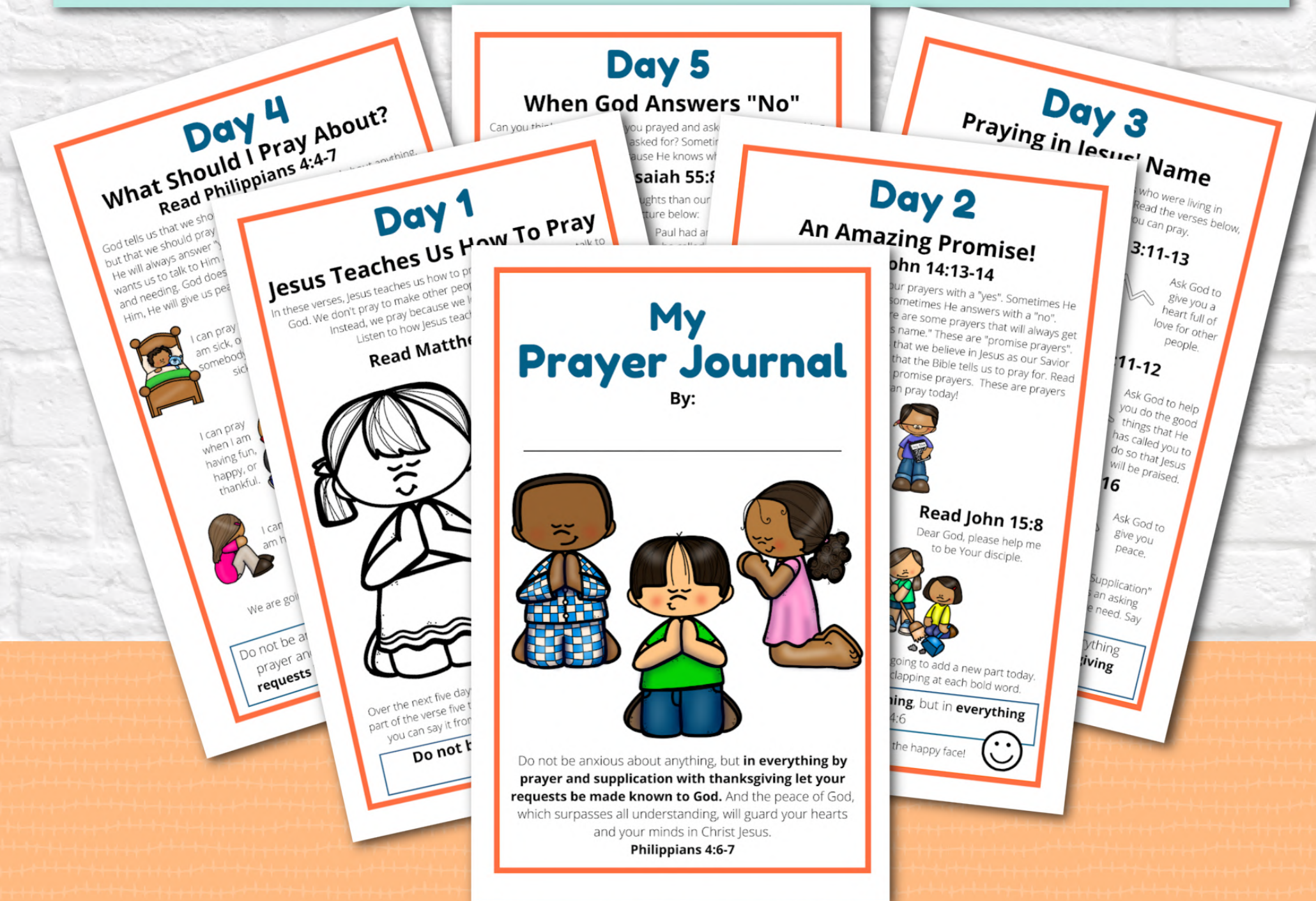

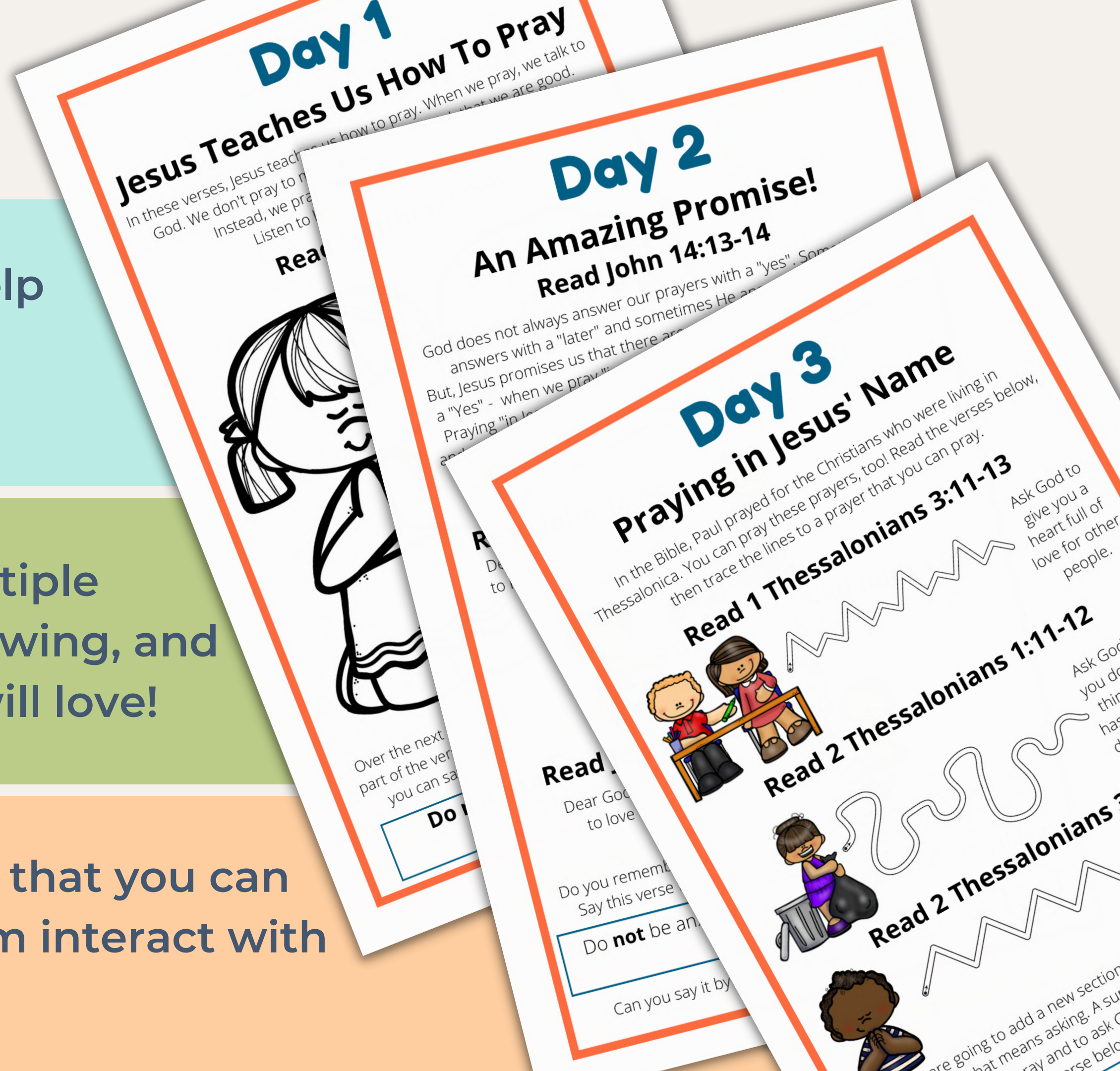

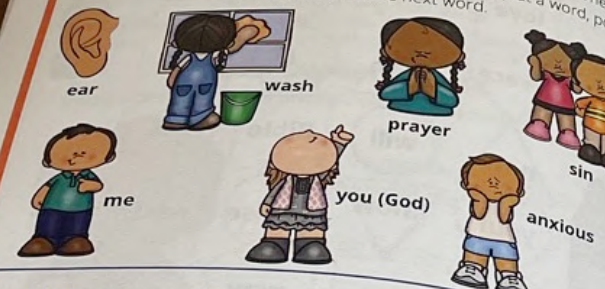
Day 15

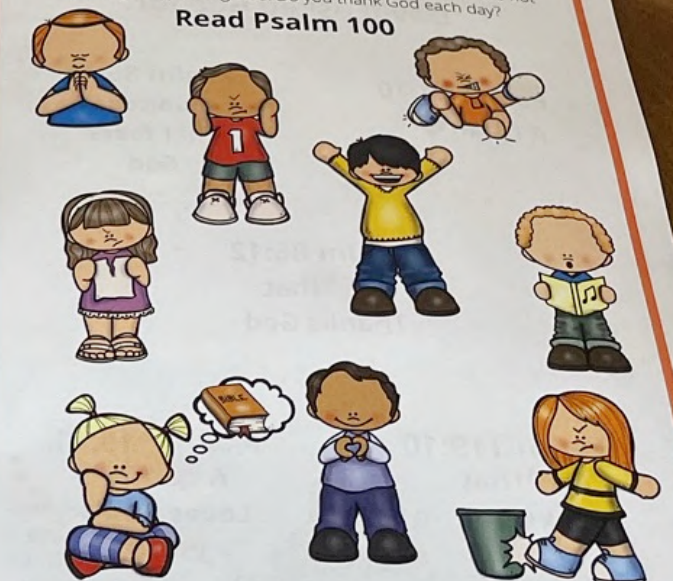

 <p>BOLDLY and fearlessly tell people about Jesus!</p>	 <p>Have an "open door" (opportunities) to tell people about Jesus!</p>
 <p>Speak clearly so that people would understand the Gospel</p>	 <p>Be rescued and protected from people who are trying to stop me from telling others about Jesus</p>

Read Ephesians 6:18-20; Colossians 4:2-4; and 2 Thessalonians 3:1-5

Read 1 Kings 3:5

Read 1 Kings 3:7-9

- To have no enemies

Read 1 Kings 3:10-14

Day 5

When God Answers "No"

Can you think of a time that you prayed and asked God for something, but you didn't get what you asked for? Sometimes God answers our prayers with a "no" because He knows what is best for us!

Read Isaiah 55:8-9

Paul had an illness or problem that he called his "thorn in the flesh". He asked God to take it away three different times, but God said "no". In the end, Paul realized that God's "no" was what was best for Paul.

Day 6

The jailer said, "What must I do to be saved?" Paul and Silas told him to believe in the Lord Jesus Christ.

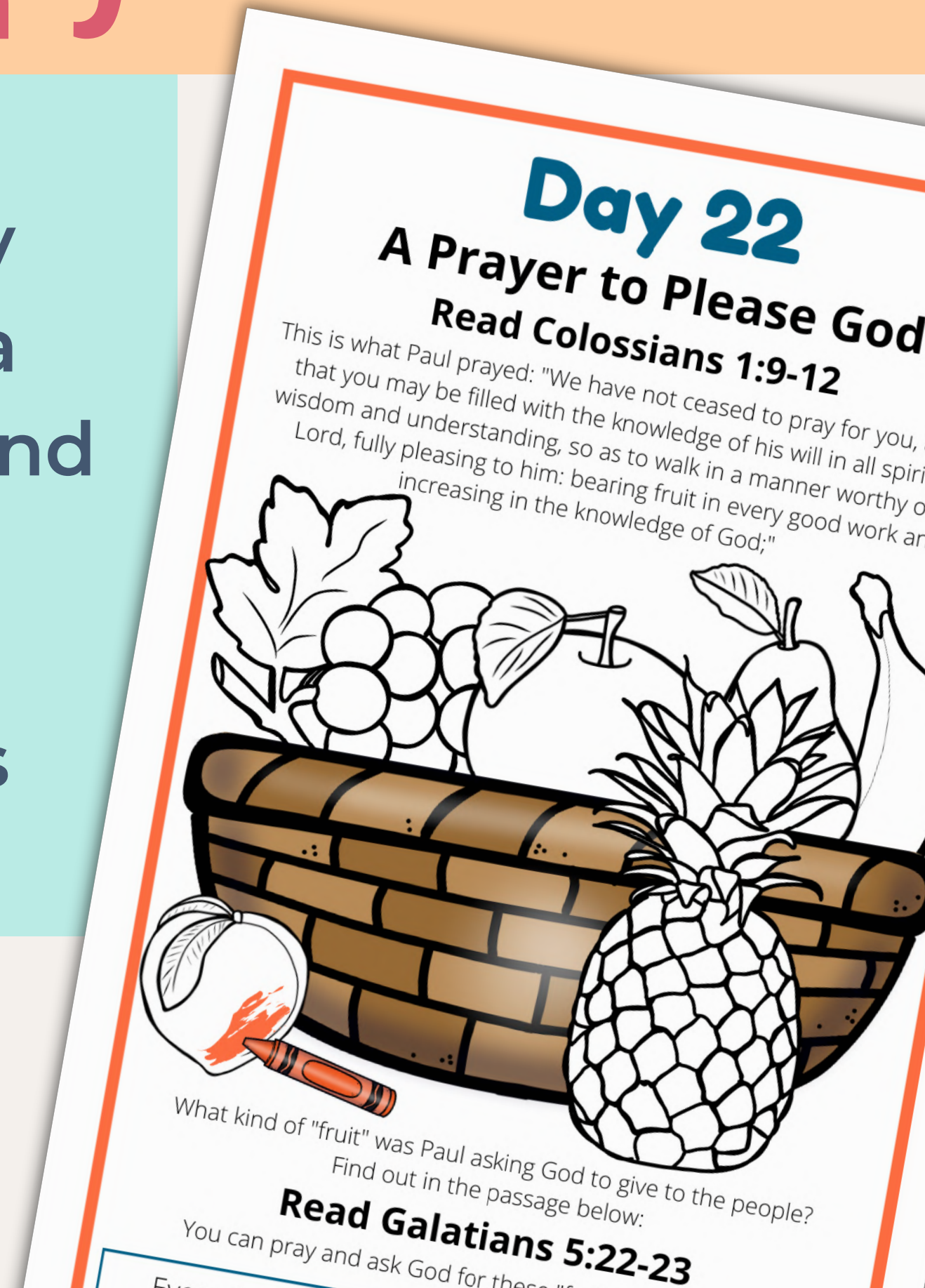
Read Romans 10:9-10

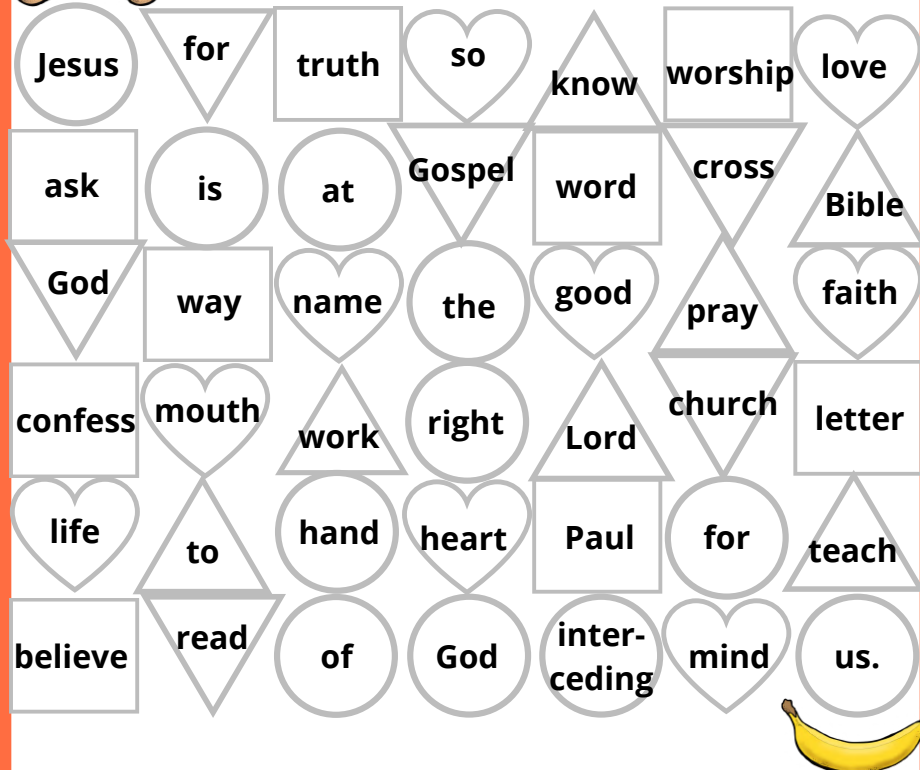


Day 31

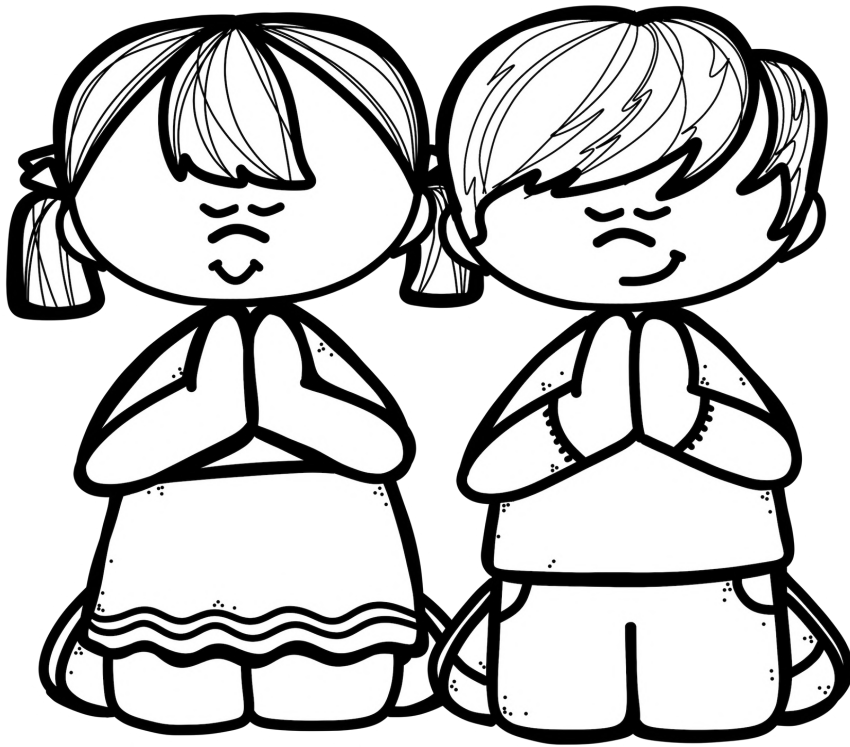

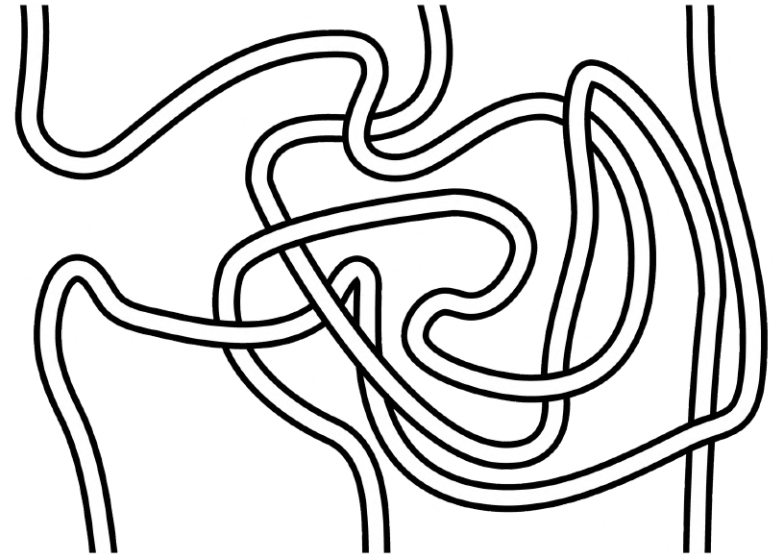

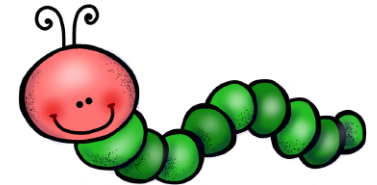

Day 29

What If I Don't Know How to Pray?

Are you ready to learn a really big word?

Here we go: The new word is "Intercede." Can you say that? To intercede means to go in between two people and help them come together.



Did you know that, if you have put your faith in Jesus Christ as your Savior, the Holy Spirit now lives in your heart? You can't see Him, but He is there. The Holy Spirit helps you to understand God's Word and He helps you to know when you have sinned. The Holy Spirit also "intercedes" for you when you don't know how to pray. He goes between you and God, helping you to pray.

Sometimes our hearts get heavy and sad. Sometimes we get frustrated and confused. We want to pray, but we don't know how. In those times, the Holy Spirit intercedes or goes between us and God, praying for us in exactly the right way! Listen to the verse below. When you hear the word "intercedes", raise your hand. Listen closely!

Day 2

An Amazing Promise!

Read John 14:13-14

God does not always answer our prayers with a "yes". Sometimes He answers with a "later" and sometimes He answers with a "no".

But, Jesus promises us that there are some prayers that will always get a "Yes" - when we pray "in Jesus name." These are "promise prayers".

Praying "in Jesus' name" means that we believe in Jesus as our Savior and we are asking for something that the Bible tells us to pray for. Read the verses below, then read the promise prayers. These are prayers that you can pray today!

Praying in Jesus' Name

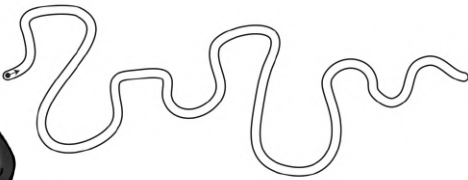

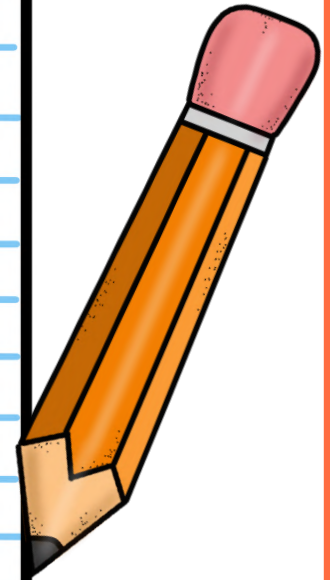
