
Day 2: How Can I be Saved?, Continued Read Acts 16:22-34. What did the jailer ask Paul ar Silas? What did they say? Read Romans 10:9-11. you believe in Jesus as your Lord and Savior? PRAY THE WORD: Romans 5:1 and Isaiah 12: Day 3: How Do I Believe? You might be wondering, "What does it mean to place my trust in Jesus? How can I believe in Jesus?" When you believe in Jesus, your heart will say, "Yes! That's I am a sinner. I have broken God's perfect law and deserve His judgment. There is no way that I can ever be good enough to save myself. (For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23 ESV) Jesus took the punishment in my place. He lived a life of perfect obedience to God. Then, He died on a cross taking the punishment for my sins so that I could be forgiven. He didn't stay dead, but rose again on the third day. (But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8 Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he Was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 ESV) Because Jesus did this for me, I want to obey Him and love Him the rest of my life. He is my Savior and Lord. (If you mouth that lesus is I ord and boliove in confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. Romans 10:9-10 ESV)



Can you say this verse from memory?


In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1 (ESV)

Day 1: In the Beginning...

Read Genesis 1:1-13. What did God create on Day 1? Day 2? Day 3? Read verse 2 again. Close your eyes and imagine that you are in verse 2. What was the world like before creation? What was the world like by the end of the third day? Read Revelation 4:11. What is one reason God deserves our worship according to this verse?

PRAY THE WORD: Revelation 4:11



Read Genesis 1:14-25. What did God create on Day 4? What is the "greater light"? The "lesser light?" What did



Day 5: Creation Finished

Read Genesis 2:15-25. What did God give to Adam in verse 16? What commandment did God give Adam in verse 17? What was the one thing that God said was not good about His creation (vs. 18)? What do you think it amust have been like for Adam to see all of God's created animals and give them names? What animals do you think might have made Adam laugh or step back in amazement? What did God do so that Adam would not be alone? Read Psalm 139:14-18 and Psalm 139:23-24. Have you ever worshiped God for the amazing way He created you, giving you a unique body, personality, and talents? God has a perfect plan and purpose for you, exactly as He created you!

Day 3: The Creation of Adam and Eve

Read **Genesis 1:26-31.** God created Adam and Eve on the sixth day. In whose image or likeness did God create Adam and Eve? What work did God give Adam and Eve to do in His created world? How did God describe His creation on the sixth day? (vs. 31) **Read Pealm 8:3-9.** Have you ever looked up into a clear night sky and been amazed at the stars and moon and planets that God created? PAT THE WORD: PSalm 8:3-9

Read **Genesis 2:1-15.** What did God make man out of? What did God breathe into man? How does this make man different from the animals God created? What two special trees did God put in the Garden of Eden? What job did God give Adam to do in verse 15? God gave Adam work to do, and He has given us work to do, as well. Read **Colossians 3:23-24.** What work do you do?
