A WARNING!

Charging tips

- 4.To ensure proper life span of your battery while car is in storage, it is strongly advised to charge battery fully every 90 days (30 days during cold weather temperatures).

Check all electrical connections and ensure there is no damage.



III. ASSEMBLY



Assembly of your new car is simple, provided you carefully follow the detailed diagram and refer to component part numbers to ensure they are fitted in the correct order as shown above.

IMPORTANT!

Before first time use, charge the battery for at least 8-12 hours. Never charge the battery longer than 15 hours.


OPERATING FEATURES

Your car is fitted with 2 gearboxes containing 2 forward speeds and 2 reverse speed. The operating speed of your car can be controlled by the middle gear lever. Pushing it all the way forward will engage forward speed on high speed. Central position of gear lever will engage forward speed at low speed. Pushing your gear lever all the way back will operate reverse gear in low speed.

Your ride-on car is equipped with **ON/OFF** switch located on dashboard. Switch must be in the on position to activate drive. In order to start your car, push gear lever forward into high speed position and place your foot onto the accelerator.

To stop your car, simply release your foot from the accelerator and this will engage the auto brake system. Your car is not fitted with a manually operated brake.


Your car has a large turning radius. To ensure unwanted collisions with obstacles, it is recommended that you drive your car in a wide open area until you get fully used to its handling and steering capabilities.



Thermal Fuse

Your car is fitted with a thermal overload fuse.

The function of this component is to protect the electrical circuit of your product. If the product is overloaded (refer to maximum user weight) or is used on a steep incline (not recommended) the thermal fuse will cut power supply to the motors and vehicle will stop. Thermal fuse will reset within 2 minutes and product function will resume as normal.




Prior to the first use of your vehicle, remove seat from vehicle and remove large flat battery compartment cover and connect battery wires to battery(red to red & black to black) as the 2nd assembly step in page 4. Please ensure colors are correct to avoid short circuiting.

Battery charging input socket is located at the bottom of the seat as shown in the image above. Plug charger output socket into input socket on your car as shown. Then plug AC adaptor / Charger into a standard 110V household power outlet. Battery should be charged for no longer than 15 hours first charge and each charge thereafter no less than 8-12 hours. Never allow your battery to run completely flat and always place battery on charger if vehicle starts to show signs of slowing down or erratic motion.

Battery charger used with the toy is to be regularly examined for damage to the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts, and in the event of such damage it must not be used until that damage has been repaired.

Operation manual: For the first time to use Need to frequency bind


- · Take out the remote control,install the battery
- . Long press on the button "M" for 2-4 seconds, Indicator light will flash
- Turn on the power of the car, Indicator light flashes to long lighting, then frequency bind succeed
- If the frequency bind failed (Indicator light flashes), remove the battery and repeat steps 1~3
- Remote control without opeeration after 10 seconds, indication light will off into power saving mode
- Button Description: ▲ forward ▼ backward ◄ turn left ➤ turn right :Speed
- P: emergency brake, press it and the running function will fail, press again, it release






- . Do not mix old and new or different types of batteries
- The exhausted battery should be removed from the remote control in time.


