


How to Use?

- Place the nebuliser on a flat, stable surface within reach
- Make sure that the nebuliser is clean and the air openings are open and working
- Connect one end of the air tube with the air outlet of the nebuliser and the other end with the medicine chamber [Attention: Do not connect the air tube too tight at either end]
- Put the prescribed medicine in the exact amount as advised by your doctor into the medicine chamber
- Close the chamber correctly
- Insert the power cable into a power outlet to appropriate voltage
- . Turn on the main switch
- Be seated comfortably in a stable manner near the nebuliser
- Now turn on the power switch of nebuliser

- Notice that the machine instantly turns the medication into the fine mist of aerosolized medicine, which indicates that it is ready to be inhaled
- Position your mouth accordingly with the mouthpiece or the mask as per your convenience and start inhalation
- Turn off the switch after usage







REMEMBER

- Check the air tube before each use for any kinks and ensure that there is no leakage
- Keep the accessories clean and disinfected for future use. Wash the medicine chamber, mouthpiece and mask with warm water and a mild detergent after every use to avoid cross-infection. Rinse them in hot running tap water. Do not wash in boiling water to avoid damage
- Replace the filters at regular intervals to prevent bacterial infections from using an unclean and clogged filter. Open the filter cap and replace the used filter which has turned grey with a new one, for an effective nebuliser treatment
- Keep the nebuliser and other accessories out of reach of small children as the small parts might be a choking hazard
