"Color" is our next judged exhibit open to all, on display in the Main Gallery September 10 - October 3. This exhibit will accept all 2D and 3D art. Artists have total creative freedom to express themselves through "Color". Receiving is September 9, from 9am - 12pm. Reception is Thursday, September 12 at 5pm. \$800 of awards and merit ribbons anticipated.

"Black & White" will be featured in Goff Gallery, September 10 – October 3, at the same time Color is presented in Main Gallery. "Black & White" is open to VAC Members only. There is no fee to enter. All artwork must be for sale and may have been previously shown in other VAC Exhibits. Receiving is September 9, from 9am -12pm. A VAC Member may participate in both Color and Black & White simultaneously. Reception for both Color and Black & White is Thursday, September 12 at 5pm.

"Harvest of Art" is Charlotte County's oldest annual juried exhibit and will be celebrating its 30th anniversary. This is not a themed exhibit. Bring in your best work of 2D paintings and drawings in oil, watercolor, acrylic, charcoal, colored pencil, graphite, pastel and mixed media. Computer generated art, photography and fiber/fabric are not eligible. Receiving is Friday, October 4 from 9am - 12pm and the exhibit will be open from October 7 – 31 with more than \$1,200 of awards and ribbons anticipated at the Reception on Thursday, October 10 at 5pm. This is a juried and judged exhibit with the expectation that entries will be reviewed and some eliminated prior to hanging.

"Off the Wall" is a different type of exhibit to be displayed in Main Gallery from December 10 – December 20 and is open to members and non-members. Enter any size 2D or 3D artwork. This exhibit will not be judged, so artwork may have been exhibited at the VAC previously. All Artwork must be for sale and priced at \$200 or less. Artwork will come "Off the Wall" as soon as it sells. Exhibit is open to members and non-members. Receiving is December 9, from 9am - 12pm.



"3D Member Show" is a totally 3D show (pottery, jewelry sculpture, basketry, fiber, glass) on display at the same time "Off the Wall" is presented in the Main Gallery, December 10 - 20. The possibilities are endless! This exhibit is open to VAC Members only in Goff Gallery. There is no fee to enter this exhibit. All artwork must be for sale and may be removed as it sells. Artworks are allowed to have previously shown at the VAC. Receiving is December 9, from 9am - 12pm.

Plein Air Festival with Plein Air Exhibit, Plein Air Workshop and Punta Gorda Quick Draw: Celebrate the new year with Plein Air Paintings by entering the Plein Air Exhibit, taking a Plein Air Workshop, participating in the Punta Gorda Quick

Draw and other festivities the first two weeks of January. Plein Air Exhibit Receiving, Monday, January 6 from 11am - 2pm. Plein Air Workshop with Dan Graziano January 6 & 7, from 9am - 3pm. The Punta Gorda Quickdraw is Monday, January 13.

The 2020 National Art Exhibition: The Biennial National Art Exhibition is one of the nation's most prestigious juried exhibitions of two-dimensional media. Entry into the 2020 NAE will be open until midnight on December 15, 2019. This exhibition is limited to two-dimensional paintings and drawings in oil, watercolor, pastel, acrylic, charcoal, colored pencil, graphite, and mixed media. Media for the Bowles Award for Portrait Excellence is limited to drawing, painting and pastel. More than \$8,000 in awards will be presented. All entries must be entered digitally via Juried Art Services at <u>www.juriedartservices.com</u>. JAS provides a comprehensive "help" menu as well as telephone and email support. Artist notification will be made by email in early January. If accepted into the 2020 NAE, you will receive further instructions by email regarding receiving and other important information.
