This will be the 30th and final year for Harvest of Art, Charlotte County's oldest annual juried exhibit. This is not a THEME exhibit. Bring in your best work! This exhibition is limited to two-dimensional paintings and drawings in oil, watercolor, acrylic, charcoal, colored pencil, graphite, pastel, and mixed media. Computer generated art, photography and fiber/ fabric art are NOT eligible. This is a JURIED exhibit. Entries will be reviewed and some eliminated prior to hanging.

ORIGINALITY POLICY

Only original works may be submitted. Any entry must be a concept entirely developed by the submitting artist and executed by his/her own hand. Duplications of another's work of art, whether by machine, hand or paint, is considered copyright infringement and may not hang in regular exhibits. Entries found not to be original will be excluded from the show and any awards revoked with no return of entry fees.

RELEASE & AGREEMENT

The Visual Arts Center (VAC), and its agents, will exercise care with respect to the property exhibited as it does in safeguarding its own property, but does not accept responsibility for the loss or damage to the artists' work during the exhibit and related activities. By entering an exhibit, the artist agrees to release and hold the VAC and its agents (including staff and volunteers) harmless from any liability, damage or loss to the artist and the artist's work arising in any way from or connected to this exhibition or related activities, or from any other loss or damage whatsoever arising from or connected to this show. The phrase "loss or damage" encompasses, but is not limited to, theft, mistaken labeling, damage by a guest or patron, damage by VAC and its staff or volunteers, damage due to environmental conditions or injury to the artist.

- Artist's name, e-mail, phone number and title of work must be written on back of entry.
- Artwork must be picked up at the specified date and time. A \$10/day storage fee will be charged. Artwork left over 15 working days will be considered a donation to the VAC.
- Only original **2D** artwork will be accepted.
- Artwork may not be removed until close of exhibition unless approved by Ex. Director.
- Artwork must have been completed within the past three years.
- Artwork in Main Gallery Exhibits must NOT have been previously exhibited at the VAC, except for the NAE, VAC Student Show, Member's Showcase, Fun Art Festival, Instructor Show and/or in Goff Gallery Exhibits.

DISPLAYING OF EXHIBIT WORKS

The Visual Art Center Exhibition Review Committee reserves the right to reject any work that is poorly presented and does not meet installation requirements. Artwork to be accepted must follow guidelines as established in exhibit "Guidelines for Exhibit" and/or prospectus for size, weight, framing and condition.

2-D

Artwork must be either gallery wrapped or properly framed. Glass or plexiglass is acceptable. Pastels must be sealed. All surfaces must be dry. Must be securely fastened with picture wire with the center wire 3" below the top of the frame. Artwork must not exceed 5' in any direction. Weight not to exceed 25 pounds.

Non-member: \$30 for 1 entry, \$40 for 2 entries, \$48 for 3 entries

High School students age 14 - 19: \$5 per entry

Visual Arts Center commission on sales is 35%
