

## Choices checklist



## - EASY SWAPS FOR LESS WASTE -

WHAT TO AVOID	HOW TO AVOID IT	<b>YES</b>
Bin Liners	Have a sealed container for 'wet' scraps, Compost or freeze until bin day, Line kitchen bin with paper	
Microbeads	Avoid these personal care products	
Laundry Microplastics	Purchase natural fabrics, Avoid washing synthetic fabric frequently or spot wash, Use Cora Ball and Microplastic wash bag	
Bottled Cleaning Products	Refill when your bottles are empty	
Food Packaging: Dry Goods	Buy from a bulk store refilling your reusable containers	
Food Packaging: Meat/Fish	Minimise consumption, Shop at the deli/butcher for paper wrapped cuts	
Food: Produce	Opt for unpackaged fruit and veg, Fill reusable fabric bags	
Plastic Straws	Opt for a Reusable Straw, Refuse when you are out	
Takeaway Coffee Cups	Use your own cup or relax and sit in	
Takeaway Utensils & Containers	Bring your own reusables first and foremost, Support vendors that have home compostable options (bamboo and non plastic-lined card), Dine in	
Bottled Water	Reusable water bottle, Refill from the tap	
Balloons, Glitter, Confetti, Glow Sticks	Replace with paper lanterns and buntings, flower petals, reusable lights	
Pet Poop in Plastic Bags	Use cornstarch based compostable bag, Have a dedicated pet poop composting system at home	
Milk Containers	DIY nut milk, Local Milk in Returnable Bottles where available, Buy in Glass Bottles	
Tea Bags	Use Loose Leaf Tea	
Plastic Food Wrap	Store food in container or jars, Use beeswax wraps	
Bathroom Plastics	Use Shampoo and Conditioner Bars, Bar soap or refill existing bottles	
Litter	Cigarette butts are plastic so place in the landfill bin, Avoid releasing balloons, Pick up litter!
