Use and Care


Use on level surfaces only, and routinely check hardware and tighten as necessary. Failure to maintain your new product may result in unsafe conditions for children.

Assembly Instructions

- Upon opening package, inspect contents to make sure all parts and components are accounted for.
- Place contents on padded or carpeted surface to avoid damage.
- Read assembly instructions on reverse carefully.



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Step 1

Begin assembly by laying all pieces on the floor. Arrange shelf 1 and shelf 2 between left side panel and right side panel with all stickers facing ceiling and arrows pointing away from you. Identify bolt holes (holes that pass through both faces of the side pieces) and dowel holes (holes that appear only on the inner face side of the pieces).

Step 2

Beginning with the bolt holes furthest away from you, insert bolts **(D)** from outside face through the threaded inserts of shelf 1. **Do not tighten at this time.**

Step 3

Choose desired shelf height for shelf 2 and repeat Step 2. Using hex key **(F)** tighten all bolts. **(D)**

Step 4

Add a drop of wood glue **(G)** in each of the holes in the left roof panel. Fit the left and right roof panels together, making sure the fit is snug.

Step 5

Stand assembled shelf upright without the top piece(s). Place a drop of wood glue **(G)** into each hole in the left and right side panels where the roof dowels will fit. Gently fit the roof assembly into place, making sure the dowels are well set in the side panels and tap gently from the top until all gaps are closed.

Step 6

Use a stud finder to locate studs in your wall. Use a yardstick to measure the distance between studs.

Step 7

Place the "figure-eight" brackets **(F)** on the top shelf to the appropriate holes to match the distance between wall studs and secure with screws **(H)**. Rotate the "figure-eights" so they point down. Use these to securely fasten unit to a wall.

For additional stability use screws **(H)** to attach side panels to the wall using the 2 "figure-eight" brackets **(F)** on the side panels near the tapered foot.
