NOUNS – CONCRETE NOUNS & PROPER NOUNS

Generally, a noun is a word we use to identify **a person**, **place** or **thing**. There are different kinds of nouns. We are starting with concrete nouns.

CONCRETE NOUNS are nouns that you can see, hear, touch, smell or taste. They include words like pancakes, rabbit, bells, girl, steam, air, space and moon.
