
ELEV 89 NZTU AERODROME

CHRISTCHURCH CONTROL: 129.3 UNATTENDED: 119.5



- 1. Simultaneous operations on parallel paved and grass runways prohibited.
- 2. RWY 11 threshold coincident with eastern edge of paved RWY 02/20.
- CAUTION: Bird hazard. Birds seasonally on aerodrome and larger number present on the outlying fields when irrigation or cultivation taking place.
- 4. Intensive gliding operations may take place particularly during weekends and public holidays.
- 5. Microlight traffic circuit 500 ft.
- Glider traffic take-off and land at an angle to RWY 11. Exercise caution when taxiing from Aero Club area to holding position RWY 11.
- 7. Turn LEFT after completion of landing on RWY 11.
- Model aircraft flying may take place during daylight hours subject to specific prior approval of the airport operator.
