

Printable Ring Size Chart 2 methods to sizing your ring



!! PRINTING WARNING!!

For accurate size measurement, this document must be printed at 100%. To do this make sure you uncheck the fit to page in your print dialogue box and set up the page scale to 100% or actual size. Use the ruler below (in method N0.1) to check the 100mm line is exact. Please Note: Do not measure on a screen, must be printed. Sizes using this page are considered approximate and may need to be re-adjusted.

Method N0.1 Finger Ring Sizer

- O1. To make the ring sizer stencil more durable, add a strip of clear tape over the ring sizer stencil.
- Using a blade, follow the dashed lines to cut out the stencil of the ring sizer and the slit.
- 03. With letters facing outwards place the ring sizer over the widest point of your chosen finger (usually the knuckle).
- 04. Insert the end of the ring sizer through the slit. The letter that lines up with the slit will be your ring size.
- **Note:** The size needs to be able to slip over the knuckle. If you are between two sizes choose the larger size.



Method N0.2 Existing Ring Sizer

- O1. Choose an existing ring from your collection that comfortably fits on the desired finger for your new ring.
- Using the circles below, move the ring between the circles until you can see the entire circle inside of the ring.
- **Note:** If the size is between two letters, choose the larger size.
